Dear parents and guardians,

Alamanda College (Prep to Year 9) is looking forward to offering another challenging vibrant year of learning opportunities for your children. We would like to advise our school community of Alamanda College's voluntary contributions for 2026.

Alamanda/schools provide students with free instruction to fulfill the standard curriculum requirements, and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary, nevertheless the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer high quality and successful academic and importantly co-curricular programs. Your financial assistance enables us to enrich the extend the learning experiences of our 3374 students by offering an enhanced curriculum and a wider range of subjects which meet the diverse needs of our 3374+ students such as multiple music groups, robotics, digital technology, theatre, primary food technology, science, Literacy and Numeracy programs which have been extended and enriched in 2025 and our Outdoor Education and Sporting program.

Recently the contributions of parents have allowed us to enhance the Wi-Fi network and improve the offerings in Year 7-9 electives, lay grass for primary students to enjoy improved play areas, replace our theatre lighting equipment to ensure we maintain a high-quality performing Arts Centre, refurbish our Sports Centre and improve our classroom libraries across Prep to Year 9.

The College does not require parents to engage in any "fundraising", we ask parents to support the College through the contributions to elective programs for students and primarily our voluntary contributions.

With your contributions for the 2026 academic year, the College intends to renew, replace and refresh the robotics equipment and enhance this program. We also plan to enhance the primary food tech program and space, including developing kitchen garden planting areas. The College also plans to increase primary science for Years 3-6 strengthening primary science, extend the digital technologies programs for students in Years 5-9. These improvements started in 2025, will continue throughout 2026.

Importantly we are building updated resources for the new primary build currently underway. These resources include but are not limited to services for primary science room in the new build, primary sports room and primary roof top sports area (specifically designed). The primary spaces will also have library spaces that we are currently resourcing.

Alamanda is a well-respected school prioritising programs and resources outside the normal scope, we rely upon our community to assist us. The funding arrangements for schools has changed in the last 24 months and your assistance is very much appreciated if we are to continue to offer the wide variety of programs and resources across the school.

With renewed generous contributions of parents, we are also able to employ additional support staff for students, improve our learning spaces and develop an enriched technology program in the classroom. We also plan to maintain the grounds and environment.

Continued arrangements contribute to making Alamanda College a school that excels.

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW



FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the requirements of the Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) including the VCE Vocational Major and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:

Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

- Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

- Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.

Educational items for students to own

- **STUDENT STATIONERY PACK – TO BE PAID DIRECTLY TO OUR THIRD-PARTY SUPPLIER**

Alamanda College is using an online only ordering system for 2026 Booklists with our stationery supplier *Paperchase Office National*. Orders will be delivered free of charge to the school for on-time orders. If you elect not to purchase the booklist through *Paperchase Office National* please consult with the school so that your child has the correct items as there may be some items that parents cannot purchase themselves.

Items provided will supply your child with all the stationery they will require for 2026 (ie. pens, colouring pencils, exercise books, etc.).

The price of \$56.73 is to ensure quality items can be included in the booklist for personal student requisites. Families can purchase from any supplier of choice but it is recommended they are bought through the school's third-party provider *Paperchase Office National* as the school can negotiate the best price by buying the items in bulk. Other advantages include all students have the same supplies and materials are of equal standard.

Please place your order online no later than Monday 15th December 2025 to guarantee your order is delivered to the school ready for the start of Term 1. Orders placed after the due date may not be processed until February due to our extremely busy schedule in January 2026.

- **YEARLY ONLINE SUBSCRIPTIONS – TO BE PAID DIRECTLY TO THE SCHOOL**

All subscriptions are individually owned by students and can also be used at home - Mathletics, PM Reading materials, Seesaw, Education Perfect, E-Platform for home use, EPIC for home use. The subscription also covers electronic device security/contents screening and management. This is purchased through the school and payable directly to Alamanda College upon book pack collection.

- **ELECTRONIC DEVICES – TO BE PAID DIRECTLY TO OUR THIRD-PARTY SUPPLIER**

Parents have a choice of ordering through two of our third-party suppliers, *JB Hi-Fi* or *Beyond The Box* or purchase your own electronic device from your preferred Apple supplier. Both third-party suppliers are aware of the school's IT requirements.

The school recommends you purchase your child's electronic device from our preferred third-party suppliers for your child to individually own and use. Please refer to the information sheet at the end of this document on how to place your child's device order.

Financial Support for Families

Alamanda College understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- **Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF)**

Parents holding a valid means-tested concession card may be eligible to apply. A special consideration category also exists. Eligible families will need to apply for CSEF at the school office with applications entered by school administration onto a web-based system.

A payment of \$400.00 for both primary and secondary school students is paid directly to the school and can be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eligible student.

- **State Schools Relief Fund (SSRF)**

SSRF may cover the cost of new uniforms, shoes or more for disadvantaged students.

Alamanda College is always available to help disadvantaged students with student requisites, uniform and loan devices. Please contact the school office should you need assistance.

We apologise if you are a new enrolment or missed the due date due to unavoidable circumstances, but the school is aware your pack won't be ready on the first day of school, so your child should not be disadvantaged.
- All packs will be delivered to the school and cannot be collected from Paperchase.
- Complete packs only can be ordered through Paperchase Booklist Website. We do not have a walk-in shop and individual items cannot be purchased. All orders must be placed online.

6. You may then either Checkout or Add Another Student.

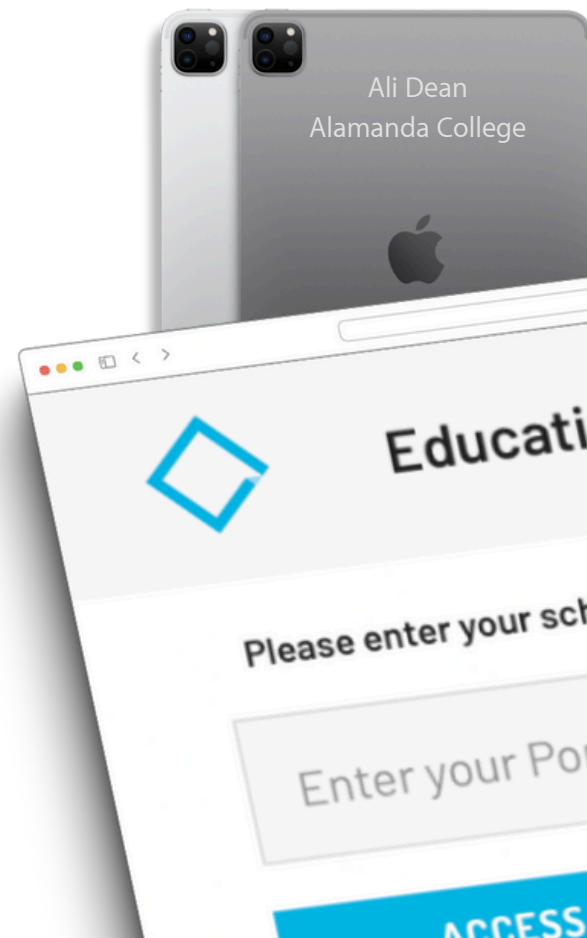
