DOMESTIC FEE INFORMATION

Our fee information is designed to be clear and easy to understand, so you know exactly what you are paying for.

We are committed to making a high-quality, caring Christian education accessible to as many families as possible. We offer sibling discounts for families with more than one child enrolled, fee assistance for eligible low-income families, and flexible payment options to help with planning and budgeting.

SCHOOL FEE BREAKDOWN

Our school fees consist of tuition fees, a general service fee, and ICT levy. These are an annual charge which is most commonly divided into four term payments per year. [Please see our website for a breakdown of Tuition Fees, General Service Fees, and the ICT Levy.](#)

TUITION FEES

Tuition is an annual fee directly related to the delivery of our course curriculum. Unless listed otherwise, they are inclusive of all curricular activities and programs, and include costs such as:

- subject courses
- teachers and teacher aides
- printed materials
- use of equipment

GENERAL SERVICE FEE (GSF)

The General Service Fee is an annual fee that contributes to items such as online classroom resources, textbook and locker hire, ID cards, certain academic competitions and selected sporting activities, excursions and associated transport, stationery for Primary students, and other classroom consumables.

ICT LEVY

The annual ICT Levy covers the provision of IT resources, including software licensing, system and internet access, school-related printing, cybersecurity measures, and ICT support. It also covers the use of classroom-based technology (iPads

Enrolment Deposit	\$200.00	A one-off, non-refundable amount per applicant, due once an Enrolment Offer is made, following an Enrolment Interview. Payment of the enrolment deposit secures the applicant's place and will be applied to the student's fee statement.
Year 7 Enrolment Deposit	\$200.00	A one-off, non-refundable amount paid by current Year 5 students at the College to secure a place in Year 7. This deposit is also applied to the student's fee statement.

DISCOUNTS

We offer several discounts to help make an education at BAC affordable for families. These discounts apply to the Tuition component of our Fees.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

We offer a discount on **Tuition Fees** to support families who have more than one child enrolled at BAC on a single fee account.

The figures listed in our table of **School Fees** are the total charge per child, and inclusive of all fees and levies.

- **2nd Child:** 15% discount
- **3rd Child:** 30% discount
- **4th Child+:** 100% discount

PROMPT PAYMENT DISCOUNT

Families who pay their fees annually or by term, and who make full payment by the due date nominated on their fee statement, are eligible for the following tuition discounts:

- **Term:** 4%
- **Annual:** 4.5%

LOW INCOME DISCOUNT

Families who hold a Low Income Healthcare Card (LIHC), or who otherwise meet our low income criteria, are eligible for a 25% tuition discount.

FLEXIBLE PAYMENT OPTIONS

We offer a range of flexible options that allow eligible families to make fee payments on a schedule that suits you. Families have the opportunity to discuss these options with our Business Manager at their enrolment interview.

OTHER CHARGES

Additional costs apply to some cocurricular and extracurricular activities. Examples are listed below.

Cocurricular Activities

- TAFE and vocational certificates
- Academic competitions and testing

Extracurricular Activities

- Certain sports teams and activities
- Secondary socials
- 12 senior jersey, Year 12 formal and graduation events, Year 6 celebration

Camps, Trips & Excursions

- **Excursions** for Primary students are included in our school Fees, as are excursions for the core subjects in Secondary.
- **Optional tours and trips** (such as the Snow Trip) that attract travel and other costs are charged separately to school Fees. Fee accounts will need to be brought up to date for students to participate in paid extracurricular activities.
- **Year-level camps** for Year 6-12 are charged separately to school Fees. The cost is estimated based on previous events, and will be confirmed with families early in the school year.

LATE PAYMENTS

Please ensure that you allow sufficient time for processing if you are paying fees by bank transfer. Funds that are not received into the College's account by the due date will attract late payment charges.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENROLMENT

We ask that you provide a full term's notice prior to withdrawing your child from the College during the academic year to avoid being charged the full term fees for the following term. Should the College be in the position whereby it is necessary to cancel a student's enrolment, or where you withdraw your child within 28 days of the beginning of the term, a fee equal to one half of the term fees will be payable.

Bus Service

REGULAR BUS USERS

Regular bus users include both full-time and part-time users who have a **permanent booking**.

- Full-time users catch the bus 7-10 times per week, on a permanent basis.
- Part-time users catch the bus 4-6 times per week, on a permanent basis.

Users catching the bus three times per week or less are charged casual fees (see below), but their booking may still be considered regular.
