**Explanation of Tuition Fees**

Tuition fees are fees that Brisbane Adventist College receives that are directly related to the provision of a course that the College is providing, or offering to provide, to the student.

Brisbane Adventist College’s Tuition Fees are inclusive of the following:

- **Tuition Fees** - Unless otherwise listed below, are inclusive of all curricular activities and programs. This may include but not limited to; provision of the school curriculum course in regards to: subjects courses, teachers and teacher aides, provision of printed materials, use of equipment etc...
- **General Service Fees (Secondary and Primary)** – Contributes to items such as Athletics, Math Pathways, textbook hire, ID cards, Sports activities, locker hire, excursions, Primary stationary, HPE activities and Sport, swimming, competitions, consumable stationary and transport to sporting events. Also included is the marketing events/materials and the production of the annual school magazine as well as non-curriculum items to support the smooth operation of the College, such as the maintenance and buildings.
- **ICT Levy** – Assist with the provision of student IT resources, including software licensing, system and internet access, printing, security, protection, filtering and custody of student IT resources. The technology levy also incorporates the operation of the College’s 1:1 Lap top program which compliments College curriculum and has proven to provide a more innovative and compelling learning experience.
- **Elective Subject/Practical subject expenses** – This involves materials needed to complete an assessment task and/or subject related excursions. Not all students will have these additional expenses unless they chose particular elective subjects listed.
- **Application Fee-** All applications must be accompanied by a \$150.00 non-refundable Application Fee.

**\*Tax deductible donations to the building fund** – all voluntary donations over 2.00 are tax deductible.



## Explanation of Non-Tuition Fees

*Non-tuition fees are compulsory and involve those costs which do not form part of the formal course of enrolment or excursions etc.*

Brisbane Adventist College's Non-tuition Fees are inclusive of the following:

- **Testing Fee** – All international Students are tested using the NILLIA Band scales and/or PAT Testing. This can be requested as part of the enrolment process or once the student has arrived.
- **OSHC Fee** – All students are required to have health cover for the duration of their studies in Australia. Brisbane Adventist College no longer organises the Overseas Student Health Cover. You will need to arrange this yourself. You can visit the following site for comparison rates <https://www.canstar.com.au/compare/overseas-student-health-cover/>
- **Queensland Studies Authority Visa FEE** – Charged by the Queensland Studies Authority for the completion of the Queensland Certificate of Education in Year 11-12
- **Stationary** – Where stationary and/or books are not supplied by the school.
- **Uniform-** Uniform is based on 2 sets of formal and 1 set of sports at various sizes as child grows, along with accessories, bags etc.
- **Personalised Sports Jumper** – In Year 12 students wear their own sport jumper that usually has their name printed on it. The year 12 students are allowed to wear this jumper as part of their Sports uniform.
- **Year 12 End of Year Events** – These events are in second semester and part of the Year 12 student's final program. Cost will vary depending on how many family members attend the Pre-dinner Formal event.
- **Homestay Placement Fee** – This is an administration fee for the setup of homestay, regular homestay checks and accountancy of homestay funds.
- **Homestay Relocation Fee** – Charged where a student has to relocate to a new homestay.
- **Homestay Fee** – cost of living with homestay family.
- **Compulsory Extra-curricular excursions/socials/camps-** these are extra-curricular activities that students are required to participate in while studying at Brisbane Adventist College.

## Explanation of Other: Optional Fees

Brisbane Adventist College offers school buses for transport as well as extra-curricular activities that are optional for students to participate in.

- **Music and Sport:** Brisbane Adventist College has a great music and sports program. Students can learn a range of instruments by our experience tutors, or be involved in the band and/or choir. - **Musical:** Every second year, year 7-12 students have the opportunity to participate in a College musical. This fee is to cover the costs involved in transport of students to venues, making of costumes and production of musical.
- **Touch, Futsal and Basketball Nationals.** Student may be selected to represent the College in one or more of these sports. They can choose to participate in these trips, representing BAC at local, state and national competitions.



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- **Extra-Curricular Excursions-** these involve excursions that the College offer that are optional for students to attend.
- **Trips (Canberra and Sydney)** In Year 7 students have the opportunity to experience the Canberra Trip – a weeks-worth of fun, activities and learning in Australia’s capital city and home to our Government. In Year 12 the students can experience Sydney. It’s a great time of bonding and full of rich learning experiences in preparation for life beyond Year 12. These trips are optional but it is strongly encouraged that they participate.
- **STORM CO and Sonship Trips (Year 10-12)** – These involve a service trip to a particular location local and overseas (Solomon Islands), where students serve and help a community in need.
