| i. | Tuition Fee | Unless otherwise listed below, tuition fees are inclusive of all curricular activities and programs. This may include but not limited to; provision of the school curriculum course in regards to: subjects courses, teachers and teacher aides, provision of printed materials, use of equipment, etc. |
| ii. | General Service Fee (Primary & Secondary) | Contributes to items such as Athletics, Math Pathways, textbook hire, ID cards, sports activities, locker hire, excursions, primary stationary, competitions, consumables and transport. |
| iii. | ICT Levy | Assists with the provision of student IT resources, including software licensing, system and internet access, printing, security, protection, filtering and custody of student IT resources. The IT levy also incorporates the operation of the College's 1:1 laptop program which compliments College curriculum and has proven to provide a more innovative and compelling learning experience. |
| iv. | Elective & Practical Subject Expenses | This involves materials needed to complete an assessment task and/or subject related excursions. Not all students will have these additional expenses unless they chose the particular elective subjects listed. |
| v. | Application Fee | All applications must be accompanied by a \$150.00 non-refundable application fee. |

Explanation of Non-Tuition Fees

Non-tuition fees are compulsory and involve those costs which do not form part of the formal course of enrolment or excursions, etc. Brisbane Adventist College's non-tuition fees are inclusive of the following.

| i. | Test Fees | All international students are tested using the NILLIA Band scales and/or PAT testing. This may be requested as part of the enrolment process or once the student has arrived. All testing will be conducted before a final decision is made on enrolment. |
| ii. | Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) | All students are required to have health cover for the duration of their studies in Australia. Brisbane Adventist College does not organise OSHC, parents or agents must apply for OSHC for the student. For information on Australian health insurance companies refer to www.oshcaustralia.com.au . |
| iii. | Queensland Studies Authority Visa Fee | Charged by the Queensland Studies Authority for the completion of the Queensland Certificate of Education in Years 11 - 12. |
| iv. | Stationary | Where stationary and/or books are not supplied by the school. |

v.	Uniform	Uniform is based on two sets of formal and one set of sports at various sizes as child grows, along with accessories.
vi.	Senior Jersey	Year 12 students wear a personalised rugby jersey, that is referred to as their senior jersey. This jersey can be worn with the College sports uniform.
vii.	Year 12 End of Year Events	These events are in second semester and are part of the Year 12 final program. Cost will vary depending on number of attendees, etc.
viii.	Homestay Placement Fee	This is an administration fee for the setup of homestay, regular homestay checks and accountancy of homestay funds.
ix.	Homestay Relocation Fee	Charged where a student has to relocate to a new homestay.
x.	Homestay Fee	Cost of living with homestay family.
xi.	Compulsory Extra-Curricular Activities	These are extra-curricular activities that students are required to participate in while studying at Brisbane Adventist College.

Explanation of Optional Extras

v.	Interstate Class Trips	Year 7 students have the opportunity to experience an interstate trip to Canberra. A weeks-worth of fun, activities and learning in Australia's capital city and home to our government. Year 12 students experience Sydney in their final year. It's a great time of bonding and full of rich learning experiences in preparation for life beyond Year 12. Although these trips are optional, BAC strongly encourages students participate.
