### REGISTRATION AND ENROLMENT FEES

<b>Development Foundation Contribution (DFC)</b>	A compulsory, non-refundable contribution is payable at the time of enrolment. Payable to the Burgmann Anglican School Foundation. The DFC is not tax deductible.	\$850

### OTHER CHARGES

<b>Annual Capital Contribution</b>	The Annual Capital Contribution of \$700 per family, per annum is charged to finance the development, maintenance, and ongoing refurbishment of the school's facilities.	
<b>Elective Subjects</b>	Subject charges may be levied on elective subjects.	
<b>Instrumental Music Program</b>	Music lessons for a variety of instruments are offered to students from Kindergarten through Year 12, and the fees are billed on a term-by-term basis. For more information, please see the Music Portal Pages.	
<b>Co-Curricular &amp; Optional Activities</b>	The costs for each co-curricular activity vary and will be announced during the registration period for that activity.	
<b>Holding Fee</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>One semester or less</b> – Full fees</li> <li>▪ <b>Longer than one semester</b> – 25% of fees at current rate for appropriate year levels while away.</li> </ul>	
<b>Notice of Withdrawal</b>	Except as otherwise prescribed in the Enrolment Agreement, a full term's notice in writing to the Principal is required of intention to withdraw a student from the School, otherwise \$650 is payable in lieu of notice, including outstanding tuition fees.

The Fixed Levy covers mandatory curriculum and student service expenses such as camps, excursions, in-school events, e-textbooks, general materials for subjects (excluding electives), study skills courses, library resources, and technology programs for students in Years 3-8. The fee also includes other miscellaneous items that are crucial for enriching your child's learning experience. This amount is charged in four equal instalments.

## SIBLING DISCOUNTS

Tuition fee discounts are available for Kindergarten to Year 12 for siblings attending the school concurrently:

<b>Second child</b>	5%
<b>Third child</b>	20%
<b>Fourth child</b>	30%
<b>Fifth and subsequent children</b>	45%

The sibling discount is applied to Tuition Fees in descending academic order.

## CHILD CARE

Our Outside School Hours Care Programs and Pre-Kindergarten Programs are recognised as ‘Child Care Subsidy Approved Services.’ Families that meet the criteria set by the Family Assistance Office are eligible to receive the Child Care Subsidy.

## VOLUNTARY BUILDING & MAINTENANCE FUND

The school operates a tax-deductible Building and Maintenance Fund. **We thank all Fund donors and invite every family to make a voluntary donation of \$200 per term or \$800 annually.** Donations can be made annually, each term or via direct debit.

### METHODS OF PAYMENT

Burgmann Anglican School relies on the prompt payment of fees to enable the school to operate. To facilitate payment, we offer a variety of options which may be made by telephone, mail, or in person:

#### BPay

The Reference Code and the School BPay Biller Code are shown on the Fee Statement.

#### Direct Debit

The school offers several options for direct debit:

- **Full Pay:** The amount of your statement will be automatically deducted on the due date.
- **Even Pay:** The school will average the balance of your term statement over five payments for each term.
- **Budget Pay:** A fixed amount is deducted on a fortnightly or monthly basis year-round. This amount will be adjusted each term to account for any additional services or changes.

#### Credit Cards / Debit Cards

- Mastercard, Visa, and American Express payments are accepted.

### CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT OF FEES

- All fees and charges are billed each term.
- School fees are due and payable in full by the end of the second week of each term.
- Building Fund donations may be paid each term.
- The School applies GST to the cost of all taxable supplies.
- Responsibility for the payment of school fee accounts rests with the parties who signed the Enrolment Agreement.
- Families experiencing temporary difficulties should contact the Chief Operating Officer before the due date to discuss payment options.
- Any payment or direct debit arrangement entered into to assist families does not undermine the School’s legal right to recover the full balance of fees incurred and owed.
- Overdue accounts may incur an administration charge of \$50.00. This charge will be applied fortnightly until the outstanding balance is paid in full.
- If a fee account remains unpaid after the third week of term the School reserves the right to ask a family to make arrangements for their child/ren’s education elsewhere.
