- Liaise with students and parents

- Engage with and support the school's co-curricular music program which may include outside normal working hours activities
- Support the Christian ethos of an Anglican School
- Other duties as required

Selection Criteria

- A relevant teaching qualification, teaching experience (preferably with Junior School aged students) and current Teacher Quality Institute registration
- Demonstrate a passion for effective teaching and learning
- Knowledge and willingness to incorporate appropriate music teaching methodologies such as Kodaly, Orff Schulwerk and/or Dalcroze
- Demonstrate skill and understanding in differentiating the curriculum to meet a wide range of learning needs and ability levels
- Ability to contribute effectively to curriculum development

- Ability to work independently and as part of Junior School and Music Teams
- Demonstrate skill and experience in outcomes-based planning and assessment
- Demonstrate skill and experience in developing learning experiences that promote higher-order thinking
- Willingness and ability to accompany student performances (guitar or keyboard preferred)
- Willingness to support the music co-curricular program
- Background in Strings would be desirable
