Special Notes:

1. 200 I.M. will start prior to the normal carnival. Competitors wishing to compete will need to nominate and be taken by parents to pool at 7.45am for warm up ready for an 8.00am start.
2. In an effort to improve event timing and flow, Semi-automatic timing will be used at this year's carnival for all 50m races.
3. Ages are the age you turn this year. This applies to young Yr 12 students also, they must race in their age.
4. Ribbons only awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in competitive each event, not individual heats.
5. All events will be run as timed finals.
6. Please note that there is no dedicated lunch break. There will be a BBQ on the day with vegetarian options as well as sausage s/wiches.
7. Students are reminded to re-apply sunscreen throughout the day. **Please remind students to bring sunscreen as per COVID guidelines**
8. House points will be deducted if you do not turn up for your nominated event.
9. When not competing students should remain in designated house areas.
10. NO students will be allowed to compete in fancy dress.

Carnival Information

Age for races is the age you are this year.

Special age divisions: 11 years → 12 years races
 19 years → 18 years races

Times will be recorded for your appropriate age and age championships.

There will be no finals due to time constraints.

All events are timed finals..

Age champions will be announced at assembly
If there is a tie on points, age champions will be calculated on a count back system.

Swimming Shield will be presented to the winning House at a School Assembly.

Please listen to all announcements

House points will be awarded to all swimmers in each event.

House Points – 1 point is awarded for swimming, 8 for 1st place, 6 for 2nd place, 4 for 3rd place and double points for Relay.

The Novelty race will take place in the 25m Indoor Pool, 2 Houses per time in your allocated session. Session 1: (yrs 7, 8, 9). Session 2: (yrs 10,11,12).

Cheering squads will be awarded points on an unofficial basis as the demand arises. Loudness and enthusiasm = points!!!

Points will also be awarded for the “Keep your house area beautiful competition”.

NCIS Carnival is on Thursday 11 March 2021 at Alstonville Pool. Top 3* competitors in each event progress to this level.

*as per the Philosophy of Sport a challenge can be made to gain a place under extenuating circumstances.

Remember to: SLIP, SLOP, SLAP and WRAP!!! All Day!

Event Progression Sheet

1. Event announced over the PA system by the announcer.
2. Entrants move directly from the House area to the marshalling area.
3. Entrants listen closely to the marshalling instructions and do not disrupt the marshalling process.
4. Having been allocated a lane, the entrant waits for the starter's instructions. Whistle / Take your marks / Beep!
5. At the finish:
Stay in your lane. Do not leave until asked to.
6. House Points: Will be awarded via the electronic timing system.
7. Ribbon awards and collection:
Ribbons are awarded to the top 3 competitors in each event.
Ribbons will be issued after the times are recorded and collated. The announcer will call the results during the course of the day and students can collect ribbons from the designated area if time permits.

General Rules For The Day

No revealing swimwear is permitted, you will be given clothing to cover up with if your swimmers are deemed revealing.

No running around the concrete areas of the pool.

Stay outside the roped area around the pool.

Reapply sunscreen during the day.

Hats must be worn at all times when not competing.

The disabled and family toilets are strictly out of bounds.

No Body paint or paper coloured streamers are to be used at the carnival.

Good sportsmanship is encouraged; Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated.

Your maturity in following the above instructions will ensure a highly successful and enjoyable day for all.

Novelty Event Coordination:

2 sessions: Kick Board Races. 1 point per entry; Only one entry per student. Max 20 students per House, per race. (i.e. 10 at each end). If 50 or more students turn up for each house, run 2 heats of 20 and see how time is running.

Years 7 - 9 from 10.00am – 11:00am

Years 10 - 12 from 11:00am - 12:00pm

We only have 2 lanes so 2 Houses only compete at a time – Max 20 mins per Session.

Important Information:

- No student is allowed in any other part of the indoor pool, at any time.
- All groups must line up at the designated Marshalling area, indicated by witches hats, outside the indoor pool building.
- All events will be started from the deep end.
- All competitors will start in the water – There will be no diving / jumping allowed!
- Make sure that you count the amount of students from each house to see whether any students need to swim twice.
- Each race is a relay race and competitors must leave the pool area immediately as they finish and move back outside on the grass.
- If we have a large group, that group will be split into 2 heats for safety reasons.
- There will be absolutely no running allowed by any student around the pool deck.
- We must have Water Safety in the water when ESL Students are competing. Please note staffing for the novelties, you may be required to be in the water.
