UNIFORM POLICY

REQUIREMENTS

Prep Uniform

Prep students wear the Sports Uniform every day.

Year 1-6 Uniforms

Year 1-6 students wear the Formal Uniform on Mondays, excursion days, for school photographs and special events.

The Sports Uniform is to be worn on PE days, Fridays, any other days, except Mondays.

For consistency of look and quality, **all uniform items must be the official version as sold in the Uniform Shop** unless otherwise stated. In circumstances where items (e.g., shoes) may be purchased elsewhere, they must fully comply with the school's requirements and expectations.

No other items are permitted to be worn in addition to or in place of the official uniform.

Appearance:

General

- All students are expected to wear the correct uniform not only at school but when travelling to and from school.
- When wearing the school uniform out in the community, it is expected that students wear it, including footwear, correctly and with pride.
- Students must be mindful that their behaviour and language is a reflection on the whole Bethany community and so must always act in ways consistent with the school's expectations and ethos whilst wearing the uniform.
- Students are not to have writing or images on their uniform at any time that it is being worn.
- School hats are to be worn during breaks, outdoors, on excursions and at all other times as directed by a staff member.
- If undergarments are worn for warmth, such as singlets, they must not be visible through the uniform.
- Students unable to wear the correct uniform must have a note from their parent/guardian outlining the reason and when the matter will be promptly corrected. In the event of a medical reason, a note from the student's relevant practitioner must be provided.

Hair

- Hair must be neat, tidy and without any spikes, severe undercuts, close shaves, or patterns.
- Hair longer than the collar must be neatly tied back with a hair tie.
- Hair ties are to be in the school colours, navy, red or white. These are sold at the Uniform Shop. Jo-Jo bows are not permitted.
- Fringes must be above the eyebrows.

UNIFORM POLICY

Makeup, Jewellery, and Hair Spray

- No makeup or nail polish is to be worn at school.
- No coloured hair spray is to be used, including sports days and special events such as free dress days.
- No jewellery is to be worn at school, with the following exceptions:
 - Pierced ears, one set of plain silver or gold sleepers or studs (one per earlobe).
 - A simple gold or silver cross on a simple chain may be worn under the uniform (for safety).
 - All jewellery must be removed when directed by staff for safety reasons (e.g., Sports events).
 - One plain watch may be worn.

Special Days/Events:

Sports Carnivals

During inter-house carnivals, students may wear the official sports uniform. Alternatively, they may substitute the sports shirt for a plain t-shirt or polo shirt in their House team colour. School hair ties in the House team colours can be worn.

Swimming Lessons

Swimming caps must be worn.

Girls - Appropriate one-piece swimming costume, or one-piece with swim shorts and/or swim shirt are to be worn.

Boys – Speedos, or swim shorts are to be worn.

Rash shirts are optional.

Swimming Carnivals

As these are outside events, rash shirts and swimming caps are to be worn.

Interschool Sport

During interschool sport, the sports uniform must be worn (unless an alternate uniform is supplied by the school). The standard black sports shoes may be replaced with specific sport shoes in some circumstances (eg. soccer boots, netball shoes) when playing the game. When travelling to and from the sports venue, the standard black sports shoes must be worn. School staff will advise when substitute footwear is permitted.

Free Dress Days

All clothing must be Sun Safe, suitable for the activities of the day (e.g., PE lessons), maintain modesty, not contain offensive/inappropriate words or images and be consistent with the school's expectations and ethos. Footwear must be fully enclosed.

UNIFORM POLICY

Year 6 Seniors Shirt

Year 6 students may wear the Seniors shirt in the following circumstances:

- Only in place of the sports shirt; and
- Only on days when PE or sport at school is timetabled.

Colder Weather

In colder weather students may wear navy gloves or a navy scarf, outside only.

Beanies are not permitted, as they are not Sun Safe, and classrooms are air conditioned.

The pullover and jacket can be worn alone or together with either uniform.

The long-sleeved Polo shirt may be worn as part of the sports uniform.

Girls may wear navy tights as an alternative to socks, not together.

Non-compliance with the Uniform Policy

Regular routine and random uniform checks will occur.

When students are non-compliant with wearing the uniform correctly and as required, excluding specific situations addressed elsewhere in this policy, several strategies may be employed by the school:

- Directing the student to correct the infringement.
- Seeking parental support for compliance.
- Requesting parents/guardians to bring a correct uniform to school for the student.
- Assisting students with genuine economic hardship to acquire a uniform.
- Confiscating items that are not permitted.
- Imposing a consequence (e.g., Missing playtime.)
- Preventing the student from participating in school events outside of the school.
- Preventing the student from participating in school activities that are not part of the essential education program within the school.
