Welcome to Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College. The following information will provide you with an overall summary about the Learning Enrichment faculty here at the College:

How are Learning Enrichment Services Provided?

- In-class support and/or withdrawal
- Adjusted curriculum and programs
- Consultation and collaboration
- Advice and referrals

What do I do if I have concerns about my child's learning?

- If you **currently** have concerns or know about a need, use the details above to call the school to speak with the Head of Primary who will refer your enquiry as needed to Learning Enrichment.
- From next year, you should liaise with your child's teacher who may then make a referral to Learning Enrichment.

What happens when my child is referred to Learning Enrichment?

- The Head of Learning Enrichment meets with your child's teacher to discuss your child's learning needs. This may include looking at work samples, discussing behaviours and social interactions, and planning for a follow up meeting where a classroom observation will occur.
- If there is an identified need, you will be contacted for a meeting to discuss your child and plan for future supports.

Individual Plans

Our teachers are incredible educators and as a result, make adjustments suiting the majority of students.

Individual Plans are required when:

- the teacher makes adjustments that are outside the norm of regular classroom delivery
- students engage with our aides for additional support

- students have a diagnosis, even if they do not require additional support.

External Providers

This may include specialists such as occupational therapists, speech therapists, psychologists and optometrists who assist with your child's needs outside of the school.

Does your child already have a diagnosis?

It is important that we have as much information as possible to ensure your child's schooling experience starts in a positive and successful way.

- Early assistance makes a difference.
- Information is knowledge and knowledge equals appropriate instruction and delivery.

If you are aware of, or if your preschool has mentioned your child has any of the following, please share this information with the College as soon as possible:

- Sensory needs
- Difficulty with noise
- Inattention, very active, can't sit still
- Refusal opposition
- ASD
- Hearing needs
- Learning needs
- Physical needs
- Medical diagnosis/es...

Gifted Education

Please let your classroom teacher know if you feel your child is performing well above what is age appropriate for them. It is important we maintain an excitement for learning and that all students are challenged to reach their full potential.
