Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

I write today to confirm the details for the staged return of students to the classroom commencing tomorrow for some year levels.

The below information outlines the plan for students' return to face to face teaching and learning:

- *From Tuesday 5 October, all Foundation to Grade Two and Year Twelve students will return to the classroom full-time, as they were at the end of Term Three.*
- *From Wednesday 6 October, once final year students have completed the GAT, regional Year Eleven students will also return to prepare for their final assessments and exams.*
- *From Monday 11 October, a staggered approach will apply so all students are back in the classroom at least part-time. Years Three to Four and Years Eight to Nine will attend school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, and Years Five to Six and Year Ten will attend on Thursdays and Fridays – while Year Seven will also return five days a week.*
- *From Tuesday 26 October, all students will be back in the classroom full-time.*

During the above times students whose year levels have not yet returned to face to face teaching and learning will continue with remote teaching and learning. On site supervision for other year levels will continue to be provided, as per below.

Attached to this letter is a visual explainer for the plan provided by the Education Department.

With the staged return of students the School is now operating with both face to face and remote delivery of classes. This means we have made the decision that all classes whether face to face or remote, will follow the normal Monday to Friday timetable and bell times. Please find attached relevant bell times.

Student Supervision

Cobram AGS will continue to provide onsite supervision for students where their parents are deemed to be authorised workers or for students who are vulnerable or have a disability.

Please ensure that the booking form is completed www.cags.vic.edu.au/supervision-request-form by 4pm each afternoon to ensure that we are adequately staffed.

Canteen

The canteen will remain closed.

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Buses

Buses will run as normal.

Mandatory Wearing of Masks

Masks will again be compulsory for students in Year Seven-Twelve. This includes bus travelers on their way to and from school.

Student Health

I would like to again remind everyone if your young person has any symptoms consistent with COVID-19 they are not to attend school and will be required to be tested for COVID-19. I also ask that prior to any test result being returned that the student remains isolated at home.

Parental access to school grounds

Whilst parent access to school remains limited, if you do need to visit the school please ensure you enter via the front office in the Administration Area and ensure you are wearing a mask.

Parent Teacher Interviews

As communicated last term, the Semester Two, Parent Teacher Interviews sessions will be held on Wednesday 6th and Thursday 7th of October - between 4:00pm to 7:00pm both days.

Vulnerable children and children of people on the authorised provider and authorised worker list are able to continue attending onsite.

Ungraded students with disability in specialist and mainstream schools return to onsite learning with their year level equivalent cohort.

If any regional LGA is returned to lockdown – all schools in that LGA will return to the metropolitan Melbourne school roadmap settings.
