Welcome to Clayfield College

Clayfield College is a place where all individuals are known, valued, and understood. Our holistic approach to student wellbeing and personal development increases students' ability to be effective, creative and collaborative learners by providing a safe environment, positive relationships, wellness and purpose. Our academic programs foster a pathway to success by delivering a dynamic student-centred learning experience that value the needs of all learners and enable students to better understand themselves.

Clayfield College is a co-educational school unlike any other in Brisbane! Founded in 1931, the College has a proud history of providing quality education in a Christian learning environment in which all students experience a sense of belonging. In 2023, the College began its transition to a co-educational day and boarding school which offers families the best of both worlds by using the distinctive Parallel Learning model.

Unique to Clayfield College, the Parallel Learning model will see students experience all the advantages of a co-educational environment as they grow and develop through their early years and Junior school. Then, from Year 7, students will begin single-sex learning streams, continuing through Years 8 and 9. In Year 10, students come together for selected classes and then benefit from fully co-educational classes in Years 11 and 12. Parents no longer have to decide between single-sex and co-education in advance. Clayfield College offers the best of both worlds - gender-specific teaching when it matters most, with all the social benefits of a co-educational campus.

Program Overview

At Clayfield College we welcome international students from all over the world, and place value on the global perspectives these students bring to our community. We are currently accepting applications for the 2026 International Student Short Term Study Program for boys and girls from Prep to Year 9.

The Short Term Study Program is an excellent opportunity for international students to learn English and experience Australian culture. This program is designed as a social and cultural immersion. As such, no academic testing or reporting will be provided. A certificate of attendance will be issued upon successful completion of the Short Term Study Program.

A Tourist Visa is required to study in Australia for up to 3 months.

Entry Requirements

To participate in the Short Term Study Program, applicants must be between 6 to 15 years of age. All students must be accompanied by a parent or approved guardian.

Uniforms

All students studying in the Short Term Study Program will be supplied with our compulsory Short Term Study Program uniform, which must be worn with enclosed shoes. Students participating in the Short Term Study Program are not permitted to wear any other items from the Clayfield College uniform.

Accommodation

Students are required to have a parent or approved guardian live with them whilst they are studying under the Short Term Study Program. Parents or guardians are responsible for arranging appropriate accommodation at their own expense.

Homestay or Boarding is not available for students participating in the Short Term Program in 2026.

BYOD

All students are to bring their own devices.

Application Process

The application process will be managed by Global Learner, our exclusive International Education Consultant. To apply for the Short Term Study Program, please contact Global Learner by email at admissions@globallearner.com.au or complete the Online Application Form available at <https://www.globallearner.com.au/enrol> which must be accompanied by the following:

- A photocopy or scanned copy of passport page with name, photo identification, passport number and expiry date.
- A 60 second video of the student, introducing themselves.

The Enrolment Registration Fee is payable upon accepting a place in the Short Term Study Program. Please note that refunds will not be issued for families that pay the \$275 Enrolment Registration Fee before being offered a place.

Applications for 2026 will open on Monday 16 March, until Friday 3 April. Families are encouraged to apply at their earliest opportunity to avoid missing out.

It is strongly recommended that families do not purchase airfares until their place in the program is confirmed.

Conditions

It is a condition of participating in the 2026 Short Term Study Program that families abide by the College's Policies and Procedures including (but not limited to) the Student and Parent Codes of Conduct.

Meals

Please note that the College does not include food for students as part of the Short Term Study Program. Families are to ensure that their child is sent to school with a healthy morning tea and lunch each day. Families have the option of ordering healthy food from the Tuckshop for morning tea and lunch, at an additional cost.

Course Costs


Course duration is four weeks, commencing 20 July 2026 to 14 August 2026 only.

Students who chose to travel outside the approved dates will not be permitted to change the dates of study, and will not be eligible for a refund for dates they are unable to attend.
