Uniform Information

Uniform is an important part of identity for our entire school community from Pre Kindergarten to Year 12 at Central Coast Adventist School. We aim to encourage a sense of pride in personal appearance and equality through the wearing of our uniform.

Correctly wearing the school uniform reflects a student's commitment to our community and align with our school values - Respect, Integrity, Perseverance and Compassion.

Students are required to comply with the School Uniform Policy as part of their ongoing enrolment at CCAS, and we thank parents for supporting the School in providing correct uniform and ensuring that it is worn according to our Policy.

General Uniform Guide

Uniform items are required to be sourced from the Uniform Shop as they are specifically branded or colour matched to the school identity.

These items include:

- CCAS jumpers, vests and cardigans
- CCAS School blazer (non-compulsory)
- CCAS Hats (all types)
- CCAS Sport uniform (polo shirts, shorts, tracksuits, etc)
- CCAS Girls skirts, shirts, dresses and pinafores
- CCAS Boys shorts, pants, shirts
- CCAS Ties for both boys and girls
- CCAS Socks
- CCAS Schoolbags

Uniform items are on display on the website, online store or at the Uniform Shop.

General Information

- Uniforms are to be clean, ironed and in good condition.
- It should be labelled with the student's full name.
- The summer uniform is to be worn in Term 1 and 4 and the winter uniform is to be worn in Term 2 and 3.
- The formal and sports uniforms, as displayed on the website and in the Uniform Shop, **are not to be intermingled**. ***Components of the formal uniform are not to be worn with components of sports uniform and vice versa. This includes the sports jacket.***
- In cooler weather, students are to wear a tie, school jumper or cardigan together with a blazer. If necessary, **non-visible** undergarments can be worn for warmth. *T-shirts, thermals and singlets, if worn under the uniform, must not be visible through the uniform.*
- All students are to wear CCAS socks. Boys are to wear navy blue socks and girls wear white socks.
- Shoes are to be well-polished and clean.
- Hem length guide for all girls is at the top of the kneecap.

Hair and Grooming

- Students are expected to keep their hair clean and tidy.
- Hair colouring, if used, is to be natural in appearance.
- Boys' hair is to be neat, tidy, above the collar and must not hang over the face. Extreme styles, ponytails and buns are not permitted.
- Boys are to be clean-shaven.
- Girls' hair must be tied back at all times (Primary School only).

Hats

Pre Kindergarten to Year 6

- School broad brim hat all year – no hat no play.

Year 7 to 12

- School branded cap, visor or bucket hat for recess, lunch and sport in Term 1 and Term 4.

Hats are not required as uniform to or from school.

Jewellery and Makeup

Girls

- Wearing a pair of small, round, gold or silver stud earrings is permitted (one stud only to be worn in each ear lobe).
- New piercings are to be done over the long Christmas holiday break and must be school compliant studs only.
- Nails must be clear/natural in appearance.
- Facial makeup, if worn, is to be natural in appearance.

Boys

- No jewellery to be worn.

Shoes

The following guidelines should be kept in mind when purchasing school shoes:

- All shoes come with a 3 cm maximum heel height advisory.
- K-2 Boys - Black, heeled, polishable leather pull-on boots.
- K-2 Girls - Black, heeled, polishable, leather buckle shoes with enclosed toes.
- Year 3-12 All Students - Black, heeled, polishable, lace-up leather school dress shoes. *Year 3 can be considered a transitional year where students aim to be in lace-up shoes at some point during the year.*

Please note that street shoes, skate-shoes, sandshoes, surf shoes, black converse-style or jogger-style and casual dress shoes are not part of the uniform.

Sport Uniform Shoes

- The only stipulation for sport uniform shoes is that the shoes (runners, cross-trainers, etc) are designed for sport and fitness wear.
- Street shoes, skate-shoes, sandshoes, surf shoes and casual dress shoes are not acceptable.

Sport shoes may be in any colour combination.

Sport Uniform

The Sport Uniform is to be strictly adhered to.

- Representative sport uniforms (eg. HRIS or CIS) are not a substitute for the CCAS Sports Uniform.
- Representative sport uniforms are only to be worn to specifically designated events, *not as general sportswear at CCAS.*

The following guidelines are for High School Students.

- Sports Uniform can be worn to and from school on Sports Days for High School students.
- Sports uniform can be worn to school if students have a practical PE class period 1 or 2. Students are required to change into school dress uniform at Recess time.
- Sports uniform can be worn home from school if students have a practical PE class period 6 or 7. Students are required to change into this uniform at lunchtime after wearing their dress uniform to school.
- Sports uniform can be worn if students have a practical PD class during period 3-5. Students are to change into PE uniform at recess and out of PE uniform at lunchtime.
- School hats are compulsory for all outdoor sporting activities.
- The school dress jumper is not part of the Sports Uniform and the Sport Jacket is not part of the School dress uniform.

Uniform Accessories

- Girls' headbands, pins, scrunchies, hair ties, etc must be navy, white or black in colour.
- Scarves may be worn in cold weather. Plain navy blue scarves only.
- Girls' tights and stockings must be black or navy.
- Non-school branded wet weather gear may be worn as required to and from school in winter but *are not a part of uniform once at school.*

Guidelines for Sports Carnivals, Swimming events or lessons

The Primary School Guidelines include:

- All items must be clearly labelled with the student's name.
- Girls must wear one-piece swimming costumes.
- Boys must wear speedos, racing jammers or board shorts.
- Goggles and towels and other personal items should be labelled with the student's name.

The High School Guidelines include:

- All items must be clearly labelled with the student's name.
- Students are allowed to wear suitable house colours or CCAS Sports uniform.
- Suitable swimming costumes with appropriate coverage, which consist of one-piece swimming costumes for girls.
- Boys must wear speedos, racing jammers or board shorts.
- Goggles and towels and other personal items should be labelled with the student's name.

Mufti Day or Non-school Uniform Guidelines

The following requirements are for school approved, non-school uniform or 'mufti' days.

- Students must wear fully enclosed shoes.
- Students must wear suitable clothing including:
 - Shirts or tops that cover shoulders and midriffs, and do not have offensive or inappropriate logos, pictures or text on them.
 - Shorts or skirts that are not excessively short.
 - Activewear is not appropriate for mufti days.
 - If a student has PE on a mufti day, then they must bring or wear footwear and clothing that is appropriate to participate in the practical lesson.
 - Students wearing clothing that is not appropriate will be asked to change or be sent home to change.
