## 2026 Annual Tuition Fees

ANNUAL TUITION FEES	BASE FEES
Primary (Prep-Year 2)	\$5,140
Primary (Year 3-6)	\$5,400
Junior Secondary (Year 7-10)	\$6,690
Senior Secondary (Year 11-12)	\$7,155

Tuition Fees cover the costs incurred in the tuition of students and include textbooks, subject materials, incursions, bus transportation for specific College events, general co-curricular sport, some College competition fees, student accident insurance, student stationery & class packs for Primary students as well as partially subsidising school camps and excursions.

**Exceptions:** Tuition Fees do not include Secondary student stationery, certain co-curricular sport opportunities and the residual portion of some camps. Please note: these activities will be communicated as and when required.

## 2026 Discount Schedule

Sibling Discounts will be applied automatically to the family fee account where siblings live in the same family unit and where sibling fees are paid together.

### PiP Levy

Parents-In-Partnership (PiP) Levy is a compulsory levy charged to all families once a year. It is a way for families to become involved in the College community through volunteering. Families can elect to volunteer at approved volunteer opportunities throughout the year which are advertised in the myCalvary news posts.

In order to have the PiP Levy credited in full, families can be involved in volunteering as per one of the options below:

- Volunteering at 1 x College event or excursion (eg: Athletics Carnival, Primary Class Excursion, etc)
- General volunteering as agreed with the volunteer area supervisor (eg: Tuckshop, Agricultural Centre, etc)

There are no partial credits for PiP Levy.

PiP Levies which have not been credited by volunteering, will go towards funding College community projects or mission initiatives, as well as ancillary aspects of College life, including fridges for primary lunches in classrooms, sports equipment, classroom furniture, equipment and infrastructure.



## 2026 Technology Levy

Camps and excursions are a compulsory part of the College curriculum, and most are included in the tuition fees. Although the above camps are partially subsidised by the College, a cost to families will still be required, as specified. ## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE

- An application fee of \$100 applies to each new family and is payable when submitting the Application for Enrolment form. Application fees are non-refundable.

### PREP ENROLMENT CONFIRMATION FEE

- There is an enrolment confirmation fee of \$200 for all Prep Enrolments. This fee is to be paid upfront and will secure the child's space at the College.
- Confirmation fees are non-refundable, however it will be credited to the family's tuition account upon the student's commencement.
- Payment Plans are available, provided it means the confirmation fee is paid in full prior to commencement.

### PAYMENTS

- Families may pay their College fees either annually upfront, directly to the College or by instalments via Edstart. Staff families may pay their fees via payroll deductions.  
**Annual Upfront Payments:**
  - When paying fees Annually, upfront and on time, a 10% discount on tuition fees (less sibling discount) will apply, provided all fees are paid in advance and are received in full by 15 February each year.
  - Please connect with the Finance team at the College regarding any annual payment queries.**Instalment Payments via Edstart:**
  - Calvary Christian College has partnered Edstart to streamline school fee payments and provide flexible options to families for the payment of school fees:
    - Pay weekly, fortnightly or monthly by choosing the schedule that works best for families
    - Ability to select the preferred day for when payments are made
    - Spread school fee payments over the full school year
    - Access a range of free payment options including bank transfers, BPAY and debit cards
    - Easily adjust payments at any time

### PRO-RATA FEES

#### Late Enrolment:

- Tuition Fees & any applicable discounts, bus fees & Creative Arts fees, will be calculated on a pro-rata basis.
- Technology Levy (Prep–Year 9) & PIP Levy are charged as flat fees, calculated on a pro-rata basis according to the term in which enrolment begins.
- Technology Levy (Year 10-12) & camp fees are a flat fee and are not eligible for pro-rata adjustment.

#### Early Withdrawal:

- Tuition Fees & any applicable discounts will be adjusted on a pro-rata basis.
- Technology Levy (Prep–Year 9) & bus fees, Creative Arts fees & PIP Levy for the term of withdrawal are non-refundable and not eligible for pro-rata credit.
- Technology Levy (Year 10-12) is a non-refundable flat fee and is not eligible for pro-rata credit.
- Camp Fees will be credited according to each camp's non-refundable terms & conditions, provided notification of withdrawal is received by the stated non-refundable cut-off date and the student is withdrawing before the camp date.

### EXIT FEES

- Both potential or definite student exits must be notified in writing to the College Registrar.
- Notification must be received a minimum of 30 days' before the last day of school attendance (term time).
- Under 30 days' notice will incur additional fees equating to 1 month's base tuition fees.
- Devices must be returned to the College in good order prior to graduating or exiting the College, to avoid being charged a potential repair (up to \$350) or replacement cost (up to \$1,800).
- Library books & textbooks must be returned to the College in good order prior to graduating or exiting the College, to avoid being charged a potential repair or replacement cost (\$8-\$120).
- Combination locks must remain on the Secondary lockers in good order prior to graduating or exiting the College, to avoid being charged a potential repair or replacement cost (\$25).
- Automated payments will cease once the final account balance has been calculated and paid in full.



## CAMPS

- Year 5 Camp is included as part of the school fees.
- Year 6 Canberra Trip is an education experience with an additional few days skiing on the snow fields.
- Year 8 & 10 Camps are outdoor adventure camps with a focus on teamwork and personal growth.
- Year 12 Camp is a celebration camp with an emphasis on friendship and fun. The fee includes the Year 12 Camp, the student's ticket to the Year 12 Formal/Graduation and a personalised Year 12 Senior Jersey.
- Camp Fees are non-refundable once cut-off dates have passed.
- If a Secondary student is unable to attend due to extenuating circumstances, the Director of Secondary College may approve a partial credit for the cost of the camp, at their discretion.
- Information regarding camps will be provided by the Primary and Secondary Offices.

## TECHNOLOGY LEVY

- This year:
  - Students in Prep, Year 1 & 2 will have access to iPad trolleys and technology in the classroom as needed.
  - Students in Years 3 to 6 are provided with a College-owned iPad to use as required in the classroom (1:1).
  - Students in Year 7 & 10 will be provided a new College-owned MacBook, which is theirs to use for 3 years.
  - Students in Year 8, 9, 11 & 12 will continue using the College-owned MacBook they were issued with.

- Technology Fees are non-refundable.
- Damaged screens and other damages to devices will incur a repair cost of up to \$350.
- Lost or unreturned laptops and accessories will incur a replacement cost of up to \$1,800.
- Repair or replacement costs for any other damage or loss of technology devices may be passed on to families, after an assessment has determined the cause and nature of the damage/loss.

## PERFORMING AND CREATIVE ARTS (PACA) PROGRAM

- The Performing and Creative Arts (PACA) Program is a dynamic program offering lessons for Voice, Strings, Woodwind, Brass, Drums, Guitar and Piano, through skilled and specialised Tutors.
- Please refer to the [Performing and Creative Arts Information](#) on the College website for more information.
- Once placement is confirmed, Creative Arts fees are to be paid by being added to automated payments.
- Lessons will be forfeited if automated payments for Creative Arts fees are not in place or not up to date.
- Creative Arts lessons and fees will automatically roll over from term to term but will not roll over year to year.
- Creative Arts fees are a non-refundable, flat fee, per term. Any missed lessons, cancellations or non-usage for the term will not be entitled to a credit or refund – including year levels that finish earlier.

## BUS SERVICE

- The Calvary Bus Department provides an excellent and safe bus service transporting students to and from the College, by servicing the main Townsville suburbs as a door-to-door service to most locations.
- Please refer to the [Bus Information](#) on the College website for more information.
- Once placement is confirmed, bus fees are to be paid by automated payments.
- Bus placement will be forfeited if automated payments for bus fees are not in place or not up to date.
- Bus bookings will automatically roll over from term to term and year to year, unless notified otherwise.
- Administration fee of \$50 will be charged for new applications or changes made with less than 7 days' notice.
- Cancellation fee of \$100 (plus pro rata bus fees) will be charged for cancellations in the first 2 weeks of term.
- From the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of term onwards, the full term's bus fees will be non-refundable.
- Bus fees are a non-refundable, flat fee, per term. Any partial bookings, week-on/week-off arrangements, missed bookings, changes, cancellations or non-usage for the term will not be entitled to a credit, refund or pro-rata – including year levels that finish earlier.

## TEXTBOOKS AND LIBRARY BOOKS

- Textbook hire, readers and lexiles are included in school fees, and are issued from the library.
- Lost or damaged library books and textbooks will incur a replacement cost which will be billed to the school account.



## STATIONERY

- Primary student stationery is included in tuition fees and is provided as required in the classroom.
- Secondary student stationery must be purchased by families and can be sourced from The School Locker or your choice of supplier.
- Please refer to the [Secondary Stationery Lists](#) via the College website or Secondary Office.

## UNIFORMS

- Please refer to the [Uniform Guide](#) on the College website for more information.
- Approved Calvary Christian College Uniforms can only be purchased through The School Locker at Shop 1B/161 Duckworth Street, Garbutt (Located in Domain Central). They can be contacted on (07) 4430-8500.

## BUILDING FUND

- The College depends on the support of the College community to continue in the development of facilities.
- Tax Deductable Donations to the Calvary Christian College Building Fund can be made voluntarily at any time.

## EXTERNAL COURSES/TAFE

- Some external courses can be arranged through the Secondary College.
- Information regarding external courses will be advised by the Pathways Advisor or the Subject teacher.
- Examples include Certificate TAFE courses, White Card qualification, Boat Licence, Scuba Diving, etc.
- Fees for approved external courses may need to be paid directly to the external entity (i.e. directly to TAFE), or paid for separately via Trybooking, or billed to the school account.

## REPRESENTATIVE COMPETITIONS

- Selected students may be given the additional opportunity to represent the College at certain competitions that may require additional cost to cover competition fees, travel, accommodation, uniforms etc.
- Examples include: CBSQ Basketball competition, QISSN Netball competition, Holy Smoke BBQ Battle, Beef Week & Cattle Shows.
- Fees for additional competition opportunities for selected students may need to be paid separately via Trybooking or billed to the school account.
- Information regarding additional competition opportunities for selected students will be advised by the Primary or Secondary College as opportunities arise.

## EXTERNAL SPORT

- Some external sports training is offered before/after school on College grounds.
- Fees for these external sports are to be paid directly to the external entity (i.e. directly to AFL etc.)

## SCHOOL PHOTOS

- Payment for school class photos is to be paid directly to the photography company.
- Photos by professional photographers at various College events & awards celebrations are available for download for free, by Geocapture, via myCalvary.

## REPLACEMENT ID CARD / STUDENT DIARIES

- The cost for replacement ID Cards (\$10) and Student Diaries (\$15-\$30) are to be paid at the Finance Office.
