At Covenant Christian School, the Sport and Recreation syllabus provides opportunities for students to: acknowledge God as the perfect designer and creator of the universe; develop social responsibility in regard to service, with a particular focus on the sport and recreation for lifelong physical activity and opportunities; use their God-given skills in caring for others; develop godly attitudes in the way they treat other people within the classroom and wider community.

Course description

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply the skills and knowledge to coach participants up to an intermediate level in a specific sport. This qualification provides a pathway to work in community coaching roles working or volunteering at community-based sport clubs and organisations in the Australian sport industry. Individuals with this qualification possess a range of well-developed skills where discretion and judgement are required. They are responsible for their own outputs.

Course content includes: customise coaching for athletes with specific needs; communicate effectively with others in a sport environment; maintain sport, fitness, and recreation equipment for activities; undertake risk analysis of activities; manage conflict; provide first aid; develop and update knowledge of coaching practices; coach beginner or novice participants to develop fundamental motor skills; plan and deliver coaching programs; a range of specific sport related units e.g. swimming, basketball, rugby.

Pathways and careers

- Possible job titles depend on the specific sport and may include community coach.
- Specific industry accreditation requirements may apply to sport-specific coaching accreditation and information should be obtained from the relevant National Sporting Organisation (NSO).

Particular course requirements

- Work placement is a mandatory HSC requirement for this Sport Coaching VET course.
- Students undertaking HSC VET courses as part of a school-based apprenticeship or traineeship will meet mandatory work placement hour requirements through the on-the-job training component of the school-based apprenticeship or traineeship.
- Students' outside employment (i.e. not under the auspices of the school) may be recognised towards the requirement for work placement in a VET course.
- Non-completion of work placement is grounds for withholding the HSC course.

Important things to consider

- There is a cost of \$200 per year for this course which includes work placement administration, first aid course (provided by a private organisation) and equipment.
- There is no guarantee that a student will receive their *Certificate III*. Students who do not complete all aspects of the course will receive a *Statement of Attainment* for successfully completed units.
- There is no ATAR given for this course, but it does count towards your HSC units.
