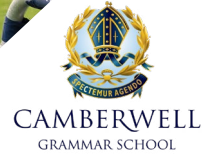




GENERAL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS (SPORT)



INFORMATION SHEET

for entry into Years 7 to 11 2027

What are the application dates?

- Applications are open until close of business (5pm) on **Wednesday, 20 May 2026**.
- Late applications will not be accepted.

Who can apply?

- Candidates are required to represent the School in their sport as a condition of their scholarship. Accordingly we only consider students playing a sport which the School competes in as part of the AGSV competition.
- Candidates should be participating at a State or National level, or are part of a talent pathway program, depending upon the sport.
- Candidates should have a school record which demonstrates a capacity to contribute to the total program of the School in academic studies, the arts and service activities.
- Applications are invited from boys currently attending Camberwell Grammar School as well as those attending other schools.
- Overseas students on a sub-class 500 student visa are not eligible to apply. Students whose families hold a residency visa are eligible to apply.

How to apply?

- Applications are only accepted via the online form found on the school's scholarship page www.cgs.vic.edu.au/enrolment/scholarships. An acknowledgement of receipt of the application will be sent by email. Late applications will not be accepted.
- A copy of your son's two most recent school reports must be attached.
- A link to a 30 second video on YouTube (or similar platform) can be submitted which captures the student actively participating in a game or training environment, but this is optional.
- If you choose to submit a video it should be a genuine and current representation of the student's ability. Footage does not need to be professionally produced;

clear, simple recordings are sufficient. The purpose is to assist staff in gaining a brief visual understanding of the applicant's skill level and potential. Avoid staged content, do not include award ceremonies, medals, or still images.

What is the cost?

- There is no cost to apply for the General Excellence scholarship program.

How much is the scholarship worth?

- Scholarships are awarded based on the application and subsequent interview. A concession on fees will be offered at the discretion of the Principal. This is not a fully funded scholarship; however, it includes access to the School Sport's Academy which incorporates both private coaching and personalised strength and conditioning sessions.
