Students may borrow a college instrument free of charge for the first six months, provided spares are available, giving time to purchase their own. It is recommended that the \$150 saved from the hire fee be put toward buying a personal instrument, which is often more cost-effective than hiring, especially for upper strings. Any damages, including accidents, will be the responsibility of the student's family.
