






DIRECTOR OF CAMPUS REPORT	Jason Smith reported on the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Mathematics pathways rolled-out in Year 7, 8 and 11. The new pathways will reflect standards and discrepancies and allow for diversification in instruction to insure student achievement across the cohorts. PD sessions are currently focussing on ways to achieve this, including changing classroom set-up. • Change in class structure for Year 9 mathematics, one class will allow for extension of students and the other will be assigned a Teachers Aid to facilitate more effective support of students in need. This lead to timetable changes and meant that some students had to change home class-finer details are still being addressed. • Year 11 reporting is moving towards Visible Learning with the implementation of electronic marking. This will ensure more transparency of learning, with progress shown at intervals that are more frequent. • Reporting across the school is currently being reviewed, with indicative results in mind. • Year 11 is preparing for ATAR, with teachers assessment tasks submitted for review.
