MOVIE DAY: BEE MOVIE

Learning Studios

Learning Studios invite the children to think through unique lenses and assume specific roles and identities. Through authentic experiences, children learn about the world and who they are within it. They play to explore and learn and the spaces respond to their emerging interests, discoveries and wonderings.

CONSTRUCTION STUDIO

think like an architect, engineer, builder, mathematician, physicist

... an exploration of construction materials and manipulative equipment as children engage in problem-solving; cooperation and collaboration; experimentation and investigation; cause and effect; spatial awareness and coordination; balance, symmetry and pattern; force and motion; design and creation.

STUDIOS OF IMAGINATION

think like a reader, storyteller, dancer, musician, actor, narrator, writer ...

... an exploration of language, story and imagination as children engage with sounds and patterns; purpose and expression; creativity and imagination; symbols and meaning; tools and materials.

MAKER SPACE STUDIO

think like an inventor, an engineer, an industrial designer, a costume designer, set designer...

... an invitation to every child to engage their unique perspective through exploration of natural materials, repurposed materials, fabrics, wool, leather, to be creative and innovative; make observations; ask questions; pose theories; make connections; consider properties and attributes; see the extraordinary in the ordinary.

VISUAL ART STUDIO

think like a painter, sculptor, potter, printer, photographer, designer, creator, chemist...

... an exploration of creative expression through visual art techniques, skills and tools as children engage with materials to interpret, transform, compose, combine and manipulate.
