2026 SCHOOL TUITION FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE

PART OF AngliSchools

Frederick Irwin Anglican School recognises the investment made by families in their children's education. The fees contribute towards a high level of education alongside ensuring that the excellence of the facilities is maintained and invested in.

Application Fees

An application for Admission Form must be completed and a non-refundable fee of \$100 must be paid per child. After receipt of the application form your child/ren will be placed on a waitlist, however this does not guarantee enrolment.

Enrolment Fee

A non-refundable Enrolment Fee of \$1,500 is payable upon confirmation of enrolment. This is not deducted from the tuition fees. No further Enrolment Fee will be payable for subsequent student siblings attending concurrently. For students commencing in Year 11 and 12 the Enrolment Fee is calculated at a pro rata rate.

Tuition Fee

Tuition Fees cover the cost of educating your child, with the exception of the costs of enrolment, resource fee, booklist, stationery, camps, incursions/excursions, outdoor education, music tuition or Vocational Education Training (VET). Some additional charges may apply for optional activities and subjects as well as special model projects in Woodwork, Metalwork, Art, Music Instrumental, Outdoor Education and Marine Biology.

Sibling Tuition Fee Concession

A reduction of 20% of the Tuition Fee is made for each student of the family concurrently attending the school, other than the eldest.

Other Fees and Charges

Booklists and stationery are generally purchased by families directly through the annual booklist program. Mandatory booklist items purchased by the school will be added to the School Fee statement.

Excursion, Activities and Camps Excursions/incursions and camp charges where possible are estimated at the start of the year and added to the School Fee statements.

Camps which are compulsory and apply to a group of students such as a year group or subject, will initially be estimated and charged to the School Fee statement and throughout the year these charges are adjusted based on the actual costs incurred, with any additional costs or credits applied to School Fee statements. As it is expected that students will attend these activities, costs are non-refundable if a student is unable to attend.

Music Tuition (Instrumental/Voice) is available to all students for instrumental and vocal lessons. Music Tuition Fees are \$45 per 30-minute lesson for a maximum of 40 weeks. A Music Amenities Levy of \$150 per student is charged to cover the provision of amenities for performances, ensembles, facilities and materials supplied by the school. For students studying multiple instruments, the Music Amenities Levy will only be charged once. Fees are charged annually with student school fees. Families' fees must be up to date to participate in this program.

Optional excursions such as the Ski Trip, Canberra Trip and Coral Bay Trip are not included above and will be separately added to the School Fee Account.

A non-refundable lock fee of \$25 will be added to all new students commencing in Secondary.

Payment of Accounts

School Fees and additional charges are billed in January for the whole year and emailed to the account holder's nominated email address.

Families that have previously nominated a payment option will continue with this arrangement unless they otherwise notify the school. Families that have not nominated a payment option need to advise the school of their preferred payment option from the table below.

Fees can be paid by Direct Debit and Credit card (MasterCard or Visa Card). As per the AngliSchools Policy, the School is unable to accept cash payments.

Notice of Withdrawal

The Principal must be given a full term's notice (10 weeks term time) in writing prior to the withdrawal of a student from the School. If a full term's notice is not provided, a quarter of the annual tuition fee may be charged in lieu of notice. If the withdrawal is due to financial difficulty, then please contact our Finance Team to discuss.

Overdue Accounts

The School reserves the right to charge and apply penalties for the late payment of the school fees and dishonoured payments. Penalties will range from \$5 to \$55. The Principal reserves the right to refuse a student to commence a new term unless the previous Term's Fees, Levies and Charges are paid in full or the satisfactory payment arrangements have been made with the Business Manager.

Responsibility for Payment of Accounts

This rests jointly and severally with the person(s) who signed the Enrolment Form. If both parents signed the Enrolment Form, one parent cannot remove themselves from the enrolment contract without consent from the school and the other parent.

2026 Student Allowances – Secondary Assistance Scheme

The State Government provides financial support to eligible parents through the Secondary Assistance Scheme. The aim of the scheme is to assist low income families with secondary schooling costs.

The Secondary Assistance Scheme consists of two allowances:

- \$235 Education Program Allowance (payment made to the school and applied to School Fee Account); and
- \$115 Clothing Allowance (payment made to the parent or carer)

Parents who hold a Services Australia Pensioner Concession Card or Health Care Card or Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue card only) are eligible to apply. Parents are invited to contact the School Office regarding this Scheme. Application forms must be submitted by Thursday 02 April 2026.

Insurance

It is recommended that parents check their health cover and insurance policies to ensure adequate medical and ambulance cover is held. All students attending this School are covered against accidental injury under a 'Student Accident Insurance Plan'.
