

Preventive Measures

Term 4 – Update 14.10.20

This is a guide only to our school's current preventive measures. Additional measures may be enacted based on community feedback and health advice.

- Hand sanitising for all students and staff upon entry to campus remains in place.
- **All visitors and staff must answer COVID safety questions when signing in.**
- Students exhibiting any signs or symptoms of flu like illness will be sent home.
- **All staff and students must get tested if they exhibit any signs and symptoms of flu-like illness. We are required to sight a negative COVID test before a student or staff member can return to campus.**
- All school buses are equipped with hand sanitiser and are cleaned after every run.
- **It is still encouraged to wear masks on all GISS buses.**
- Hand washing routines and regular hygiene/social distancing education for all students remain in place.
- Additional cleaning of high touch surfaces & sanitary facilities is provided throughout the day.
- Daily cleaning with focus on sanitising classrooms and common areas remains in place.
- Hand sanitiser is being provided throughout the school.
- Playground equipment is being sanitised at least twice a day.
- External visitors are strictly limited to essential meetings, contractors, etc.
- Please drop off and pick up your child without delay and do not enter the school courtyards.
- **Please do not enter the school premises unless you have an appointment.**
- GISS Kiosk encourages pre-orders via the Flexischools app.
- Excursions and interschool activities have resumed for term 4.
- All water bubblers are open again. We still recommend to prepare a filled water bottle for your children.
- Staff meetings are conducted via Teams.

Please continue to ensure to keep your child at home if they, you or anyone in your immediate family are exhibiting flu-like symptoms and get tested immediately.
