



## Academic Scholarship

Students entering Year 7 in 2021 or 2022 are encouraged to apply for an Academic Scholarship. Whilst our targeted year levels are Year 7 and Year 10, scholarships can be awarded to all other year levels between 7 and 12, under special circumstances and are assessed on an individual basis.

Academic Scholarships are awarded for a maximum 3-year period and are reviewed annually. The discount applies to Tuition Fees only and does not include boarding fees.

Please note that an application must be received for consideration before any assessment or formal offer can be made. Each application is assessed on an individual basis and treated in a confidential matter.

To apply for an Academic Scholarship (Year 7 to Year 10 entry in 2022) via the ACER exam, please register online [here](#). Registrations for ACER costs \$120. The exam will take place at Ipswich Grammar School on Saturday 27 February 2021. Registrations close at midnight on 8 February 2021.

The following will also be requested as part of your application:

1. Scholarship Application Form
2. Enrolment Application Form
3. Two most recent semester school reports
4. Most recent Naplan report
5. A copy of the applicant's birth certificate
6. A resume of achievements, including certificates, reference letters, awards, team photos, race times/distances, memberships, leaderships, and/or media articles
7. \$120 ACER Registration Fee
8. \$150 Enrolment Registration Fee (for those unable to sit the ACER exam)
9. Interview with the Deputy Headmaster
10. ACER Exam results

All applications must be submitted in PDF format via the online Enrolment Form. No hard copies will be accepted, no staples and no display folders.

Applications will be assessed and if short-listed, the applicant will be invited to attend an interview with the Deputy Headmaster. Following this interview, you will be notified in writing whether or not a scholarship will be offered.

The key criteria for awarding Academic Scholarships at Ipswich Grammar School are:

- Overall academic performance and future potential
- Diligence and application in academic studies



- Achievement and involvement in other areas of excellence such as performing arts, visual arts, sport, music, debating or other relevant areas
- A demonstrated sense of community
- Leadership capacity
- ACER Exam results
