1. IDENTITY

The College believes that the uniform is an important part of the school's identity, and that students should wear it with pride and distinction. Each student is expected to be properly attired in full uniform whilst at the College, travelling to and from school, and when representing the College at external events and functions.

When an exceptional situation arises that prevents a student from wearing part of the College uniform, a written explanation from a parent or guardian must be provided and permission sought by the Homeroom/Classroom Teacher or Head of Year/Head of Junior School.

2. JUNIOR SCHOOL

2.1. SUMMER UNIFORM (GIRLS): YEAR 1 to 6

The summer uniform is worn in Term 1 and Term 4. This summer uniform consists of:

- 2.1.1. Summer Blue dress
- 2.1.2. Navy blazer optional unless Year 6 Student Captain
- 2.1.3. Black lace-up shoes, year 1 to 6, NO Mary-Jane style or Dr Martens style allowed
- 2.1.4. Iona summer socks
- 2.1.5. School jumper
- 2.1.6. Iona straw hat, (brim down)
- 2.1.7. Iona stripe ribbon
- 2.1.8. Year 6 Student Captains may be required to wear the blazer with the summer uniform when representing the College (Student Leadership Conferences) or at formal College occasions (e.g. Open Day, College Masses).
- 2.1.9. The College hat is to be worn to and from school during Terms 1 and 4.
- 2.1.10. The summer dress must be worn at knee length.
- 2.1.11. The Junior School Reversible Bucket Hat must be worn during recess and lunchtime throughout the entire year.

2.2. SUMMER UNIFORM (BOYS): YEAR 1 to 6

The summer uniform is worn in Term 1 and Term 4. This summer uniform consists of:

- 2.2.1. Iona blue shirt
- 2.2.2. Iona shorts
- 2.2.3. Navy blazer optional unless Year 6 Student Captain
- 2.2.4. School jumper
- 2.2.5. Black lace-up shoes
- 2.2.6. Iona Summer navy socks
- 2.2.7. Year 6 Student Captains may be required to wear the blazer with the summer uniform when representing the College (Student Leadership Conferences) or at formal College occasions (e.g. Open Day, College Masses).
- 2.2.8. The Junior School Reversible Bucket Hat must be worn during recess and lunchtime throughout the entire year.

2.3. WINTER UNIFORM (GIRLS): YEAR 1 to 6

The winter uniform is worn in Term 2 and Term 3. This winter uniform consists of:

- 2.3.1. Pinstripe tunic or pinstripe skirt
- 2.3.2. Navy blazer optional unless Year 6 Student Captain
- 2.3.3. Iona White Shirt
- 2.3.4. Black lace-up shoes and Iona winter socks
- 2.3.5. Iona school jumper.
- 2.3.6. Iona school tie
- 2.3.7. The Junior School Reversible Bucket Hat must be worn during recess and lunchtime throughout the entire year.
- 2.3.8. Year 6 Student Captains may be required to wear the blazer with the winter uniform when representing the College (Student Leadership Conferences) or at formal College occasions (e.g. Open Day, College Masses).
- 2.3.9. The pinstripe tunic/skirt must be worn at knee length.

2.4. WINTER UNIFORM (BOYS): YEAR 1 to 6

The winter uniform is worn in Term 2 and Term 3. This winter uniform consists of:

- 2.4.1. Iona blue shirt
- 2.4.2. Navy blazer optional unless Year 6 Student Captain
- 2.4.3. Iona shorts or trouser
- 2.4.4. Iona school jumper
- 2.4.5. Iona School tie
- 2.4.6. Black Lace-up shoes
- 2.4.7. Iona navy stripe socks
- 2.4.8. Year 6 Student Captains may be required to wear the blazer with the winter uniform when representing the College (Student Leadership Conferences) or at formal College occasions (e.g. Open Day, College Masses).
- 2.4.9. The Junior School Reversible Bucket Hat must be worn during recess and lunchtime throughout the entire year.

2.5. JUNIOR SCHOOL SPORTS UNIFORM: PRE-PRIMARY to YEAR 6

Students are required to wear the correct Iona sports uniform on the specified Physical Education days, while training and during matches, unless directed otherwise.

The full sports uniform is the College tracksuit, (pants and jacket), Iona sports polo shirt and shorts for Physical Education days or the House coloured polo shirt for Sport days. In summer, the tracksuit jacket and pants can be excluded if it is too warm to wear.

Compulsory uniform items are as follows for Physical Education days:

- 2.5.1. Iona white polo
- 2.5.2. Iona sport shorts
- 2.5.3. Runners are to be appropriate for physical activity. Extreme colours, solid Fluro colours, solid black, Street shoes, casual shoes, volleys, or Nike Free Runs are not acceptable footwear for any sport or Physical/Outdoor Education activities organised through the College.
- 2.5.4 Iona swim cap & house swim cap Years 4 to 6
- 2.5.5. Iona sports socks
- 2.5.6 Iona bathers Years 4 to 6
- 2.5.7. Iona rash vest Years 1 to 6
- 2.5.8 Iona track jacket & pants
- 2.5.9. Junior School Reversible Bucket Hat
- 2.5.10. It is compulsory that all students wear the Reversible Bucket Hat and apply sunscreen for Physical/Sport education lessons.

The following guidelines apply to wearing the sports uniform:

- 2.5.11. The Iona jumper is not to be worn at any time with the sports uniform.
- 2.5.12. Iona bike pants may be worn over school bathers for water activities.
- 2.5.13. Iona bike pants may be worn during Physical Education/ Sport Education lessons; however the Iona shorts or tracksuit pants must be worn over the top.
- 2.5.14. Thongs are not to be worn with the sports uniform unless participating in water-based activities at the pool or beach.
- 2.5.15. Tracksuit pants are not to be rolled up.
- 2.5.16. Rash vests in Physical Education/Sport Education classes for Years 1-6 are compulsory in all aquatic activities.

2.6. KINDERGARTEN UNIFORM

The Kindergarten Uniform consists of:

- 2.6.1. Iona Kindy shirt
- 2.6.2. Iona sports shorts
- 2.6.3. Iona ELC Track top and pants.
- 2.6.4. Iona Kindy reversible bucket hat.
- 2.6.5. Runner/sneaker should be easy to take on and off and suitable for running and climbing.

2.7. OTHER UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- 2.7.1. All students must use the Iona backpack, sports bag, Library bag and pencil case.
- 2.7.2. All students require an Iona house art smock.
- 2.7.3. Black lace-up shoes are a uniform requirement for year 1 to 6 and cannot be substituted with the 'Mary-Jane' style or Dr Martens styles.
- 2.7.4. The Iona jumper is not to be tied around the waist.

2.8. SUN CARE POLICY

- 2.8.1. Throughout the year all students must wear their Junior School Reversible Bucket Hat during recess and lunchtime and are to apply sunblock.
- 2.8.2. It is compulsory for Years 1-6 students to wear a rash shirt when participating in any form of aqua sport or swimming.

2.9. GROOMING AND APPEARANCE

- 2.9.1. Students are expected to take pride in their personal appearance and are to be neatly attired and well groomed.
- 2.9.2. The summer dress and winter skirt are to be knee length.
- 2.9.3. Uniforms are to be clean and ironed.

2.10. JEWELLERY

Only the following jewellery items are permitted:

- 2.10.1. A plain wristwatch (Smart Watches are not encouraged)
- 2.10.2. One small pair of matching sleepers or small stud earrings, which may be worn in the lower ear lobes: or a single small stud earring in the upper ear lobe or tragus.
- 2.10.3. A thin chain with either a small cross or a single religious medal may be worn around the neck.
- 2.10.4. All other jewellery is liable to one term's confiscation.

The following is not permitted:

- 2.10.5. Body piercing that is not outlined above, including tongue piercing, nose piercing, eyebrow piercing, and lip piecing. Plastic retainers are not permitted.
- 2.10.6. Spacers in the ear lobe.
- 2.10.7. No tattoos or henna.

2.11. HAIR

- 2.11.1. Hair that is collar length or longer is to be completely tied back in a neat and tidy fashion (boys and girls).
- 2.11.2. Hair accessories are to be simple ties and are to be College colours; white, light blue or dark blue.
- 2.11.3. For formal occasions hair accessories must be light blue in Terms 1 and 4 and dark blue in Terms 2 and 3.
- 2.11.4. Extremes of hair colour are not permitted. Hair that is obviously streaked, tinted, or dyed, or of a colour not natural to the student, is not acceptable.
- 2.11.5. Extreme and untidy hairstyles are not permitted, e.g.: Bali braiding, teased hair or shaving any part of the head which constitutes an extreme haircut.
- 2.11.6. Layered hair that is long must be tied back and pinned back from face. The Principal/Head of Junior School reserves the right to decide the acceptability of hair styles.

2.12. MAKE UP

- 2.12.1. Mascara, eyeliner, foundation, or any other make- up is not to be worn by students in uniform.
- 2.12.2. Short, clean nails free of any coloured polish, including acrylic or shellac etc. are expected at all times.

3. SENIOR SCHOOL

3.1. SUMMER UNIFORM

The summer uniform is worn in Term 1 and Term 4. This summer uniform consists of:

- 3.1.1. Iona summer dress
- 3.1.2. Black lace-up shoes, no Dr Marten style with yellow stitching.
- 3.1.3 Iona summer socks.
- 3.1.4. Iona school jumper, permitted to be worn to and from school as the outermost garment.
- 3.1.5. Iona straw hat, (brim down)
- 3.1.6. Iona Stripe ribbon
- 3.1.7. Students may be required to wear the blazer with the summer uniform when representing the College (Student Leadership Conferences) or at formal College occasions (e.g. Open Day, College Masses).
- 3.1.8. The Iona straw hat is to be worn to and from school during Terms 1 and 4. Hair is worn in low styles to accommodate wearing the hat.
- 3.1.9. The summer dress must be worn at mid knee length.
- 3.1.10. Students are encouraged to wear sunglasses outdoors during the summer months.
- 3.1.11. Either the College hat or sports cap must be worn during recess and lunchtime during Terms 1 and 4.

3.2. WINTER UNIFORM

The winter uniform is to be worn during Term 2 and Term 3. The winter uniform consists of the following:

- 3.2.1. Blazer (outer most garment)
- 3.2.2. Pinstripe Skirt
- 3.2.3. Iona White shirt
- 3.2.4. Iona School Jumper
- 3.2.5. Iona pinstripe Tie
- 3.2.6. Iona Ink Navy Tights
- 3.2.7. Black lace-up shoes
- 3.2.8. Navy Stripe hair ribbon
- 3.2.9. The winter uniform must be worn mid knee length.
- 3.2.10. Students are required to wear the blazer when travelling to and from school, College Assemblies, Year Level Assemblies, College Mass, representing the College, (Student Leadership Conferences), or at formal College occasions.

3.3. OTHER UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All students from Years 7-12 must be dressed in their formal school uniform for the following occasions:

- 3.3.1. Whole College Assemblies
- 3.3.2. Whole College Mass
- 3.3.3. Year Level or House Mass
- 3.3.4. All other formal school occasions, events, and school excursions.
- 3.3.5. Year Level Assembly (unless otherwise advised).
- 3.3.6. Students must use the College school bag and College sports bag.
- 3.3.7. All uniform items must be clearly labelled with the student's full name.

3.4. YEAR 12 CARDIGAN

- 3.4.1. Year 12 students will be offered the opportunity to purchase a specific item of uniform clothing to wear as part of their formal uniform.

3.5. GROOMING AND APPEARANCE

- 3.5.1. Students are expected to take pride in their personal appearance and are to be neatly attired and well-groomed.
- 3.5.2. The summer dress and winter skirt are to be mid knee length.
- 3.5.3. Uniforms are to be clean and ironed.

3.6. JEWELLERY

Only the following jewellery items are permitted:

- 3.6.1. A plain wristwatch (Smart Watches are not encouraged).
- 3.6.2. One small pair of matching sleepers or small stud earrings, which may be worn in the lower ear lobes: or a single small stud earring in the upper ear lobe or tragus.
- 3.6.3. A thin chain with either a small cross or a single religious medal may be worn around the neck. No choker styles allowed.
- 3.6.4. All other jewellery is liable to confiscation.

The following is not permitted:

- 3.6.5. Body piercing that is not outlined above, including tongue piercing, nose piercing, eyebrow piercing and lip piecing.
- 3.6.6. Plastic retainers are not permitted.
- 3.6.7. Spacers in the ear lobe.
- 3.6.8. No tattoos or henna.

3.7. HAIR

- 3.7.1. Hair that is collar length or longer is to be completely tied back in a neat and tidy fashion.
- 3.7.2. Hair accessories are to be simple ties and are to be College colours, light blue or dark blue.
- 3.7.3. For formal occasions hair ribbons must be worn, sky blue in Terms 1 and 4 and stripe ribbon in Terms 2 and 3.
- 3.7.4. Extremes of hair colour are not permitted. Hair that is obviously streaked, tinted, or dyed, or of a colour not natural to the student, is not acceptable.
- 3.7.5. Extreme and untidy hairstyles are not permitted, e.g: Bali braiding, teased hair or shaving any part of the head.
- 3.7.6. Layered hair that is long must be tied back and pinned back from face.
- 3.7.7. Deputy Principal Senior School reserves the right to decide the acceptability of hair styles.

3.8. MAKE UP

3.8.1. Mascara, eyeliner, foundation, or any other make-up is not to be worn by students in uniform. This includes false eyelashes.

3.8.1. Short, clean nails free of any coloured polish, including acrylic or shellac/SNS etc. are expected at all times.

3.9. DRESS FOR EXCURSIONS

3.9.1. Students are required to wear their full school uniform on excursions. This includes the Blazer. If it is necessary for students to wear the sports uniform, the full College tracksuit must be worn.

4. SENIOR - SPORTS UNIFORM

Students are required to wear the correct Iona sports uniform during Physical Education, Outdoor Education and Sport Science lessons, while training and during matches, unless directed otherwise.

The full sports uniform is the College tracksuit (pants and jacket), Iona sports polo and sport shorts. In summer, the tracksuit jacket and pants can be excluded if it is too warm to wear.

Compulsory uniform items are as follows for Physical Education classes:

4.1. Iona sports polo

4.2. Iona sport shorts

4.3. College tracksuit, (jacket and pants)

4.4. Iona sports socks

4.5. Iona sports cap

4.6. Iona bathers

4.7. Iona rash top

4.8. Iona Swimming cap

4.9. House Swimming cap

4.10. Runners are to be appropriate for physical activity. Extreme colours, solid fluoro colours, solid black, street shoes, casual shoes, Volleys, Air Forces or Nike Free Runs are not acceptable footwear.

4.11. All girls are to carry their sports uniform in the Iona sports bag.

4.12. It is compulsory that all students wear the sports cap and apply sunscreen for Physical/Outdoor education/ Sport Science/Dance lessons.

The following guidelines apply to wearing the sports uniform:

4.13. The school jumper is not to be worn at any time with the sports uniform.

4.14. Bike pants may be worn over school bathers for water activities but not for IGSSA Swimming.

4.15. Bike pants may be worn during Physical Education/Outdoor Education/Sports Science/Dance lessons however, the Iona shorts or tracksuit pants must be worn over the top before and after activities.

4.16. If a second pair of bathers is worn for modesty, they must be of a similar design and colour to the College bathers.

4.17. Thongs or slides are not to be worn with the sports uniform unless participating in water-based activities at the pool or beach.

4.18. Tracksuit pants are not to be rolled up.

4.19. Rash tops in Physical Education/Outdoor Education classes are compulsory in all aquatic activities.

4.20. Any team specific item is not to be worn as part of the Iona Sport or Day Uniform.

4.21. All Students must change into their full school uniform at the completion of their Physical/Outdoor Education/ Sports Science/ Dance lesson. (Some exceptions apply, see below)

4.1. ARRIVING TO SCHOOL IN SPORTS UNIFORM

Students may wear their full sports uniform, (track jacket & pants, shorts, sports polo), to school if:

4.1.1. They have training before school (co-curricular sport)

4.1.2. There is an Interhouse/Interschool Sports Carnival.

4.1.3. They fit the criteria to receive an All-Day PE Pass (see below).

4.2. PHYSICAL EDUCATION PASSES

A stamp acknowledging the Physical Education pass will be placed in the College planner for a specific day if a student meets the following criteria.

- 4.2.1. Morning PE Pass (stamp in College Planner) - Will be issued to students who attend a morning sport at Iona and then have Physical Education, Outdoor Education or Dance in periods 1 or 2. This Planner stamp allows the student to remain in sports uniform in Homeroom and period 1 and must be shown to the Homeroom and Period 1 teacher. The student must change into full College uniform at the completion of their Physical/Outdoor Education/Dance lesson.
- 4.2.2. All Day PE Pass (stamp in College Planner) - Students are permitted to wear the Physical Education uniform all day (including to and from school) if they have 3 practical classes or sports in the one day. This stamp will be placed in the College Planner by the Physical Education office and must be shown to Homeroom and class teachers. Students who meet the criteria to wear the uniform all day must come to the Physical Education office and receive a signed and dated note that will also have the classes listed on it.
- 4.2.3. Students who do not receive a PE Pass will be issued with a uniform infringement notice for wearing the uniform incorrectly.
- 4.2.4. Students are to present their PE Pass (College Planner stamp) to the teacher in each lesson.

4.3. WEARING SPORTS UNIFORM DURING SCHOOL

- 4.3.1. Girls may wear the full sports uniform in normal classes if the student has 2 practical lessons or sports during the day that are within 4 periods of each other. For example, if a student has PE in period 2 and then Outdoor Education in period 5 the student may remain in the sports uniform. If a student has Outdoor Education in period 1 or 2 and afterschool training the student must get changed after the practical lesson into full College uniform. The student's timetable must be shown to all teachers.

4.4. WEARING SPORTS UNIFORM ALL DAY

Students may wear the sports uniform all day in the following situations:

- 4.4.1. Interhouse Sports Carnivals
- 4.4.2. Competing in an Interschool Sports Carnival
- 4.4.3. Student spectators must wear the full school uniform.
- 4.4.4. Specific excursions/incursions
- 4.4.5. If directed to do so on Student Wellbeing Days or Reflection Days.
- 4.4.6. They fit the criteria to receive an All-Day PE Pass (see above).

4.5. LEAVING SCHOOL IN THE SPORTS UNIFORM AT 3.25pm.

- 4.5.1. Students participating in after-school training or IGSSA games may leave school in their full sports uniform, or in the uniform that is specific to their sport, e.g. yellow socks for hockey.

4.6. SPORTS UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR SELECTED SPORTS

- 4.6.1. **AFL Football:** Football jumper and shorts, (hired from the Sports Department), football socks, (purchased from the Uniform Shop), and football boots, (recommended).
- 4.6.2. **Athletics:** Iona competition singlet, Iona sport shorts, (field events), or the Iona bike pants, (track and jump events). Iona sports cap and Iona sports socks. The full College tracksuit is to be worn when not competing.
- 4.6.3. **Basketball:** Basketball top (hired out by Sports Department), Iona sport shorts and Iona sports socks.
- 4.6.4. **Cross Country:** Iona competition singlet, Iona bike pants, Iona sports socks. The full College tracksuit is to be worn when not competing.
- 4.6.5. **Hockey:** Iona competition top, Iona sport skort and Iona stripe socks. Shin guards are required. Hockey boots(recommended)
- 4.6.6. **Netball:** Iona sports skort and netball top or Iona netball dress, Iona bike pants and Iona socks.
- 4.6.7. **Rowing:** Iona Zootie, College tracksuit, Iona sports cap
- 4.6.8. **Soccer:** Iona competition top, Iona sports shorts, long stripe football socks and shin guards required and soccer boots, (recommended).
- 4.6.9. **Softball:** College Sports shorts, competition top, long stripe socks and Iona sports cap.
- 4.6.10. **Swimming:** Iona bathers, Iona Swim cap, Iona sport shorts and sport polo and College tracksuit. Goggles and Iona towel, (recommended).
- 4.6.11. **Tennis:** College sports skort, competition top, College sports cap and socks.

- 4.6.12. **Volleyball:** College competition top, sports shorts, Iona sports cap and Iona sports socks.
- 4.6.13. **Water Polo:** College white polo shirt and shorts, College bathers and Iona swim cap.

4.7. TRAINING ATTIRE FOR ALL SPORTS

- 4.7.1. The College polo shirt and College shorts are to be worn for all training sessions.
- 4.7.2. Protective Gear
- 4.7.3. A mouth guard is compulsory for hockey and AFL football.
- 4.7.4. A mouth guard is highly recommended for netball, basketball, softball, and water polo.
- 4.7.5. It is compulsory for students to wear shin guards or shin pads when playing soccer and hockey. It is highly recommended that the girls wear shin guards when playing softball.

5. SUN CARE GUIDELINES

- 5.1. When outdoors in Terms 1 and 4, all girls are to wear their Iona straw hat or sports cap during recess and lunchtime and are to apply sunblock.
- 5.2. Iona Sports caps must be worn during all Physical Education/Outdoor Education/ Sports Science lessons.
- 5.3. The Iona straw hat must be worn with the brim down to ensure maximum protection from the sun.
- 5.4. Students are encouraged to wear sunglasses when outdoors during the summer months.
- 5.5. All students are to wear Iona rash tops when swimming in Terms 1 and 4.
- 5.6. It is compulsory for all students to wear a rash shirt when participating in any form of aqua sport and all Physical Education/ Outdoor Education activities.
