Re: 2021 Tuition Fees

The College Board recently confirmed the 2021 Budget. This letter is to advise you of our fee structure for 2021.

The Board has been very conscious of the financial pressures that exist for many families given the difficult circumstances we have endured this year with the effects of COVID-19. We have carefully balanced the need to go on improving our College, and yet to rein in costs as much as possible. Without compromising the academic program, we are pleased to announce there will be **no tuition fee increase for 2021**. As we move towards an unpredictable new year, we will continue to monitor the situation with the ongoing impact of COVID-19.

A reduction in the Tuition Fee applies for second and subsequent children. A 10% sibling discount is available for the second child; 25% for the third; and 50% for the fourth and subsequent children. Sibling discounts apply only while children are all attending the College at the same time. Tuition Fees for 2021 are illustrated in the detailed fee schedule attached. Please note that Term Fee statements are issued during the school holidays prior to the commencement of each term.

Fees are payable by the first Friday of each term.

Failure to pay fees at the required time may jeopardise the place reserved for your child's education at Josiah College. Late payment of fees may be subject to a late payment administration charge. Fees paid on time according to a staged plan arranged with the College will not attract late payment penalties.

During 2020, the College has been able to assist several families with short-term fee relief. We urge you, that if you are experiencing financial hardship to contact our business office via email at feesupport@emmanuel.qld.edu.au. We do not want any family to feel that they must leave the school during these times due to financial difficulties. We are willing to support you for as long as we can or until you get back onto a sound financial footing again. We stand ready and willing to assist any family that is experiencing significant financial difficulty.

We also recognise there are families amongst our community whose income has not been significantly affected or who have sufficient resources, and we ask that you consider donating to the Necessitous Circumstances Fund to assist families in financial need. The development of Josiah College facilities remains a priority. If you are in a financial position to do so, I would encourage you to continue to support the College by donating each term to the College's Building Fund when you make your fee payments.

Sibling Discounts

A family discount is available if one or more siblings, normally residing in the same residence, attend the school at the same time.

Settlement and Due Dates for 2021 Fee Payments

Fees are charged each term over a four-term school year. A full fee statement is issued during the holidays prior to the commencement of each term. Fees are payable by the first Friday of each term. Failure to pay the fees at the required time will jeopardise the place reserved for your child's education at Emmanuel College, and may incur Late Fee penalties in accordance with the Fees Payment Policy. We reserve the right to terminate a student's enrolment at any time if accounts are not settled on time or in accordance with a written agreed payment plan.

Student Insurance

Our Student Accident Insurance Policy covers all students for most accidental injuries for 24 hours, 365 days per year. Copies of the insurance brochure are available from the College.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The supply of educational courses is GST free, except for the portion paid on the Student Accident Insurance premium contained within these fees.
