- have an interview
- have their referees contacted
- have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) and/or VIT Card and provide other photo ID
- have participated in an induction of relevant school policies and procedures including Child Safety Standards and their role as a volunteer;
- sign in at front reception whenever arriving at the school;
- always be under the supervision of the classroom teacher when engaged in learning activities;
- always be under the supervision of the principal or delegate when engaged in activities that have little or no student contact.
