Additional Discount

5% discount is offered on the annual tuition fees if paid in full by Friday 30th January 2026. Discount applies to tuition fees only, so is not applicable to levies. Annual discount is applied after any eligible sibling discounts have been deducted.

Sibling Discount

Discounts are applied for two or more siblings from the same family, the eldest child is classed as Child 1; then the next eldest child is classed as Child 2, etc.

Notice Period for Withdrawal of Enrolment

Notice of withdrawal of a child must be provided with at least one Term's notice in writing. If such notice is not provided, the school reserves the right to charge one full Term's fees and levies in lieu of the required notice.

Financial Assistance

Limited short-term financial assistance may be available to families who are experiencing genuine financial hardship. Parents can submit an application for a means tested fee concession which will be treated in the strictest confidence. The School also offers a limited number of bursaries and scholarships. TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

LORDS is located next to Ormeau Railway Station and has a direct link between the school and the railway platform. Apart from the train network, there are also Translink bus services that run from the railway station and service the local area. In addition to the public transport system LORDS offers a bus service available to families for morning pick ups and afternoon drop offs.

The School uses the RollCall software system to allow parents through an App to make payments, track the location of buses in real time, and book additional trips. Students will tap on and tap off the bus for each trip which allows parents to monitor their location through the RollCall App.

OUTSIDE SCHOOL HOURS CARE (OSHC)
