INTRODUCTION

LORDS Uniform Policy

At LORDS we encourage students to take pride in their uniform and their appearance. Adhering to the uniform and dress code will assist students in developing a positive self-image and attitude. A student who wears their uniform with pride reflects on the student's self-respect for themselves and the school.

The purpose of a policy on school uniform is to provide for the staff, parents and students a clear and common understanding of what is required in the wearing of the school uniform.

LORDS is a full uniform school and the uniform is to be worn by all students attending the school. Parents are expected to support this policy by providing clean uniforms that are in good condition and comply with this policy.

Students in all year levels are expected to observe the details of correct attire while on school premises, representing the school on all excursions and out of school hours in public places.

All students are required to wear the correct uniform to and from school, and any other public places visited before and after school.

All items of the uniform must be clearly marked with the student's name.

Loss of any uniform is the responsibility of the student.

LORDS uniform colours are navy, burgundy and gold.



Should there be any query about the uniform or grooming regulations please do not hesitate to contact the Principal or Head of Sub-School. The Principal / Head of Sub-school may prescribe alternative clothing to be worn for special occasions or camps, particular excursions, sporting competitions or changes to weather conditions.

SECONDARY SCHOOL Uniform Requirements

The following information applies to all students of LORDS:

- Items of sports uniform are not permitted to be worn with the formal uniform. This includes the sports jacket only being able to be worn with the sports uniform. However, the shell jacket may be worn with both the sports uniform and formal uniform.

YEARS 7-9	Summer	Winter
Formal Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Middle School LORDS Formal Shirt • LORDS Formal Skirt/Shorts/Skort, on or below the knee, (no rolling up at the waistband), or LORDS Long Pants • Black leather belt with long pants or shorts • Navy LORDS School Socks with school colours of burgundy and gold • Black leather lace up shoes (no sports/casual) • LORDS Formal Hat 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inclusion of LORDS Jumper / pullover or shell jacket • Navy / skin-coloured stockings can be worn

Shorts with long socks or long pants may be worn to formal events. Girls skirts to be on or below the knee, not above the knee.

YEARS 10-12	Summer	Winter
Formal Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior School LORDS Formal Shirt • LORDS Formal Skirt/Shorts/Skort, on or below the knee, (no rolling up at the waistband), or LORDS Long Pants • Black leather belt with long pants or shorts • LORDS Senior School Blazer* • Navy LORDS School Socks with school colours of burgundy and gold • Black leather lace up shoes (no sports/casual) • LORDS Formal Hat 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inclusion of LORDS Jumper / pullover or shell jacket / blazer* • Navy / skin-coloured stockings can be worn (<i>the shell jacket may be worn with both formal and sport uniforms to school, but cannot replace the blazer for formal occasions</i>)

* LORDS Senior school blazer is a compulsory part of the formal uniform and is worn by students in Year 10, 11 and 12.

- The blazer is worn for all official occasions, for example: LORDS Celebrates, Valedictory, School Photos.
- Shorts are not to be worn to formal events, only long pants.

- Boys are required to wear the school tie when directed. This will be for formal events & occasions.
- Boys shirts tucked into pants with belt on.
- Girls skirts to be on or below the knee, not above the knee. (no rolling up at the waistband)

Year 12 Senior Jersey is a special privilege of being in the graduating class. Year 12 students are permitted to wear their Senior Jersey with both their Sports and Formal uniform. There will be occasions, as directed by staff, where Year 12s must wear their Senior Blazer, rather than their Senior Jersey.

SCHOOL HATS

Uniform Requirements

LORDS aspires to be a SUN SMART school as a matter of student's health and well-being.

- LORDS School hats must be worn to and from school
- All students are to wear (not carry) their hats whilst walking around the campus and remove them during class, chapel and assembly
- Hats must be kept in good condition or will need to be replaced.
- LORDS formal hats are to be worn whilst wearing formal uniform. LORDS Sports hats are to be worn while wearing the sport uniform (for PE lessons and at any other sporting event).
- LORDS Sport or formal hats are to be worn during all school breaks (morning and lunch).

SCHOOL BAGS

Uniform Requirements

- A LORDS navy school bag is compulsory for all students. There is a Junior (Prep-6) and Secondary (Year 7-12) navy backpack.
- Junior and Senior roller bags and navy sports bags are available for purchase at The School Locker.
- LORDS Sports bags may be used instead of the Backpack when attending sporting events.

PERSONAL GROOMING

Uniform Requirements

To enhance the presentation of the school uniform, students are required to maintain a neat and clean appearance at all times, including travel to and from the school and while visiting public places.

JEWELLERY

- Students can wear a plain watch. Prep - Year 6: Smart watches need to be checked in at the office as we do for all mobile phones. Year 7-12 may wear a smart watch but must be removed for exams and standardised testing (eg NAPLAN) as directed by staff.
- A small religious symbol on a fine chain is permitted to be worn around the neck inside clothing. No other jewellery is acceptable. Medical identification tags may be worn.
- Ears may be pierced and students may wear plain gold or silver studs or small plain sleepers (one only in the ear lobe). Clear studs are acceptable in other ear piercings. Coloured, pearl, jewelled or other types of earrings are not permitted.
- Cultural Bracelets and anklets are not permitted.
- All other forms of body piercing are unacceptable.

*If jewellery is required to be worn for religious reasons, please see your Head of Sub School to discuss.



PERSONAL GROOMING

Uniform Requirements

HAIR

- All hair should be neat and tidy, tied back if the hair is below the collar line. Fringes must be above the eyebrows and must not obscure the student's vision or cover the student's face.
- Hair is not to be shorter than a number three (3) blade. No patterns to be cut into hair.
- Hair accessories should be plain and include hairbands, clips, ribbons, elastics and scrunchies in the school colours of navy, burgundy and/or gold or in the same natural colour of the hair.
- Any kind of dyed/coloured hair that is extreme or not natural looking (for example – multiple colours) is not permitted.
- Undercuts, mohawks, mullets, rat's tails, horsies and other extreme hairstyles are not permitted.

MAKEUP/FACIAL

- Students are not permitted to wear makeup (including mascara) while at school (light foundation that contains sunscreen is acceptable). Students will be asked to remove it.
- Eyelash extensions are not permitted.
- Students are to be clean-shaven, which includes no sideburns, beards, facial hair etc.

NAILS

- Only clear nail polish is permitted. No patterns, colours or jewels are permitted. **False nails are not permitted.** Nails should be trimmed to a safe length to participate in Sport.

TATTOOS

- Tattoos are not permitted, either temporary or permanent. If already present, they must be covered up at all times.
- **No other accessories may be worn with the formal or sports uniform.**
- **Students who do not attend to their grooming requirements will be sent home to attend to the matter.**



THE FORMAL UNIFORM

Uniform Requirements

SHOES

- **School formal shoes must be black leather lace-up shoes. Shoelaces need to be tied not tucked into shoes.** Suede, buckles, high heels, canvas, coloured stitching, volley, or sports shoes are not acceptable formal shoe attire. *Fashion or sports-style shoes, including Air Force 1-type shoes, are not considered school shoes and are not allowed.*

SKIRTS/PANTS/BELTS

- The length of the LORDS skirt, skort/dress is to be on or below the knee not above the knee.
- All students need to be aware that shorts, trousers, skorts, and skirts are to be fitted and must be worn on the waistline. These items are not to be rolled up at the waist band.
- Year 7-12 students are required to wear a black leather belt with formal pants. Key rings, chains etc. are not to be attached to belts.
- Long LORDS pants can be worn by all genders with a formal shirt all year round.
- Students have the option of wearing skorts with a formal shirt from Years 1 – 12 all year round. The skort length is to be on the knee.
- Year 7-12 must also wear the school belt with both the formal shorts and formal pants.
- Navy / skin-coloured stockings can be worn.

SHIRTS/TIES

- If the formal shirt is designed to be tucked into shorts / long pants, then it needs to be tucked in. Years 1-6 and Years 7-9: Formal shirts with a straight hem can be worn out over trousers.
- T-shirts are not to be worn underneath LORDS formal or sports shirts.
- Boys in Years 10-12 are required to wear the school tie, when directed. This will be for formal events and occasions.

BLAZERS

- Year 10-12 students must wear the LORDS Senior School Blazer with the formal uniform for any special events or formal occasion as directed by staff.

Prep students are to wear sports polo and shorts for their uniform all year.



THE SPORTS UNIFORM

Uniform Requirements

The LORDS Sports uniform is worn for P.E. lessons, sporting events, and at all training sessions.

- The LORDS tracksuit is a component of the Sports Uniform and is to be worn for Physical Education / Sporting events if students require additional warmth. Tracksuit sleeves and pants are not to be rolled up. The new shell jacket may also be worn.
- LORDS Sports hat is compulsory for all students and must be worn for sporting activities or events, P.E., carnivals, or any other outdoor events.
- The LORDS Sports polo is to be worn for all P.E. lessons, general sports, and competitions against other schools (where team uniforms are not required). The LORDS House Shirt may be worn instead of the Sports Polo Shirt unless representing LORDS outside of school.
- Sports shoes must be worn on allocated sports days, including special notified events.
- Sports Shoes are to be ALL black or ALL white lace-ups only. Volleys, converse, street/skate shoes are not appropriate.
- Sports navy ankle/sport socks with burgundy and gold trims are to be worn with the sports uniform.
- T-shirts are not to be worn underneath school sports shirts.
- For house competitions (swimming, cross country, and athletics) students are able to wear a gold (or yellow), burgundy (or red) or navy (or blue) sun smart shirt.
- The LORDS Indigenous House Shirts may be worn at House events (swimming carnivals, cross country, athletics carnivals, and other inter-house competitions throughout the year). During Reconciliation Week and NAIDOC Week students are encouraged to wear House Shirts. They can also be worn on regular PE or Sports days, but not when representing LORDS at sporting events.
- Skins may be worn under the Sports Uniform, but should not be visible.



THE SPORTS UNIFORM

Uniform Requirements

SWIMMING

Years 3-12 require own swimmers for carnivals. Swimmers should be one piece and appropriate for competition. LORDS swimming caps are also required.

COMPETITION TEAMS

The school participates in a variety of sports. Team sports require a uniform specific to those sports. Students selected in such teams will be notified of requirements in team selection letters. Sports team uniforms are not to be worn for P.E. lessons.

SPORTS UNIFORM FROM YEAR 1 - 12

Students in Year 1-12 wear their sports uniform to and from school on the allocated PE and Sports days. Students should wear Sports Uniform at training (not casual clothes). Students must change into formal uniform unless they have PE and school sports training at lunch or after school.

DISTRICT TRIALS

Students representing LORDS at district trials must wear the LORDS Sports Uniform. For sports not offered at LORDS, appropriate attire for the sport should be worn.



FREE DRESS DAYS

Requirements

There may be occasions when students are encouraged to wear plain clothes to school for fundraising events. A gold coin donation may be requested. Clothing must be neat, clean, in good condition, respectable in all aspects, and suitable for the activities of a normal school day.

Closed-in shoes (both at the toe and heel) are required (no thongs, sandals or high heels).

The following items are not permitted:

- **short shorts, bare midriffs, strapless dresses or tops, backless dresses or tops, singlet tops, see-through clothing, tank tops, leggings, and any article depicting a slogan, image or name contrary to the ethos of the school.**

Students who wear inappropriate clothing will be asked to change or return home. Normal school rules apply to appearance. Sun-smart Hats are still required to be worn on plain clothes/free dress days.
