- 2 A discount of 2.5% is provided on tuition fees only for families who pay the annual tuition fee payment and capital levy by the due date of Term 1 fees.
- 3 Kindergarten fees are inclusive of the 600 hours free Kindy in Queensland initiative.

Sibling Discount

The Sibling Discount is offered across both Moreton Bay College and Moreton Bay Boys' College, for siblings who attend either College at the same time.

The discount applies to students in Kindergarten to Year 12. The discount does not extend to children attending the Early Learning Centre.

Camps and Co-curricular Activities

Moreton Bay College endeavours to have an all-inclusive tuition fee that covers the cost of tuition and a range of curricular and co-curricular activities. School camps and some co-curricular activities will incur additional charges. Private music tuition fees are to be paid either directly to the music teacher (sessional staff), or to the College as charged on your statement of account each term (where the teacher is a permanent staff member).

Billing Frequency, Payment Options and Due Dates

Account options include per term or per annum. Payment options include BPay, EasyPay, direct debit or credit card. Note additional charges will apply to credit card payments.

Fee Policy

The tuition fees payable for Kindergarten to Year 12 are set by the Board annually, and changes to tuition fees will be communicated to parents in advance of any changes taking effect.

A late fee of \$150 will be charged per term where fees remain unpaid by the due date.

Notice of Withdrawal

The College requires written notice of not less than one full school term in advance for withdrawal of a student. Notice is required on the final day of school term, which is immediately before the end of the term in which the student is intending to leave. For example, should your daughter be leaving by the end of Term 4, notice is required by the last day of Term 3 in the year of departure. A late notice fee of one term's fees will be payable by families who do not provide the required notice.
