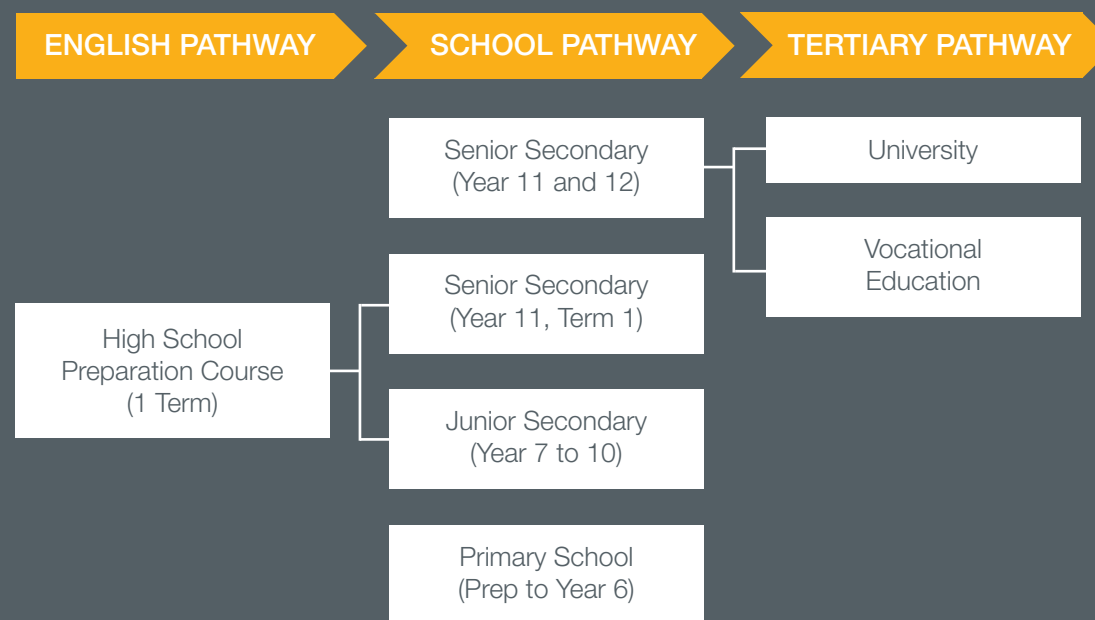

# How to apply

<b>Step 1 – Apply</b>	<b>Step 2 – Eligibility</b>
Submit your International Student Application Form with supporting documents.	Upon receipt of your application, an enrolment interview (face-to-face or online) will then be arranged
<b>Step 3 – Offer</b>	<b>Step 4 – Organise your Visa</b>
A successful application and interview will result in you receiving an offer from the College to read, sign and return. After payment, a COE will then be issued.
