

What to Bring

About a month before you leave home, you should visit our website to get more information about the school, moving to and living in Queensland, and studying at the College. Visit www.mbc.qld.edu.au and www.mbbc.qld.edu.au.

Take copies of all your documentation, including your passport, visa and airline tickets. Use the checklists below to ensure that you are fully prepared for your life in Australia:

For your travel:

- Passport and Travel Documents
- Airline tickets and student visa details
- Personal identification (e.g. ID card), with an English translation
- Australian money for the first week (about \$500) and access to Australian money in a bank account (about \$2000). Open a bank account before you leave your country by visiting www.commbank.com.au/movingtoaustralia
- Health insurance (OSHC) details if already purchased

For your study:

- Letter of Offer or Confirmation of Enrolment from the College
- Receipts of any payments you have made including tuition fees, homestay fees, etc.
- Stationery
- Dictionary (Paper only)

For your Health:

- English translation of prescriptions for any medications
- First aid kit
- Insect repellent
- Vitamins
- Cold/Flu tablets
- Lip cream
- Sunscreen

Personal:

- Glasses, contacts and sunglasses
- Mobile phone & charger
- Camera
- Electronic translator
- Towel
- Swim wear
- Hats
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Personal hygiene products
- Hairbrush
- Soap and shampoo
- Tissues
- Sewing kit
- Other necessary personal belongings
