

# Business Statement Fees & Charges 2026

## Registration & Establishment Fee

The following non-refundable fees apply:

**Registration Fee** \$50 / student application  
*Applies to all enrolment applications / registrations.*

**Establishment Fee** \$350 / student  
*Applies to all families and is payable upon acceptance of place offer.*

## Annual Tuition Fees & Compulsory Levies

The following Tuition Fees, Infrastructure Levy and Student Resources Levy have been approved by Mazenod College for 2026 and are inclusive of compulsory outdoor education, excursions and retreats, provision of College supplied 1:1 laptop computer, network infrastructure and associated software licences.

Please note that additional extra-curricular activities such as voluntary elective trips/immersions or the Private Music Program are not included. Consequently, these events and programs are separate to the Annual Tuition Fees and Compulsory Levies and any costs associated with these events and programs will be charged to the Parent(s)/Guardian(s) separately should your son(s) participate.

Fees and charges are reviewed annually and remain fixed throughout the year unless significant and unforeseen circumstances arise.

College accounts are sent out at the beginning of the year in late January / early February and paid in full within one month unless family elect to pay the Account by instalments. Accepted payment methods are cash, cheque, BPay, credit card (Mastercard or Visa) or credit / debit card direct debit.

**The College would appreciate any student withdrawing from the College to notify the Mazenod College Admissions Manager ONE TERM prior to the anticipated finish date.**

**Failure to provide four (4) weeks' notice prior to the anticipated finish date will incur a \$1,000 administration fee.**

## Infrastructure Levy

The College **Infrastructure Levy** in 2026 is \$900 / student reflecting the continued growth in investment required to support prioritised improvements to College facilities, facility enhancement to support our educational offering and pathways and the continuing need to invest in technology including our 1:1 laptop program, network infrastructure and vigilance on all aspects of College campus and cyber security to ensure a Child Safe environment for your son(s).

## Student Resources Levy

The **Student Resources Levy**, introduced to the annual Fees & Charges February invoice in 2023 (previously invoiced by student / by subject choice in prior years), has moved beyond a limited (largely) digital resources model by student by subject to a whole of College funding approach to contribute to the increasing cost of digital resources, compulsory activities, camps, outdoor education and excursions as well as the breadth of material supplies across Art, Science and Vocational Pathways.

The College Student Resources Levy in 2026 reflects the graded year levels in line with Tuition Fees:

<b>Years 7/8</b>	\$100 / student
<b>Years 9/10</b>	\$110 / student
<b>Years 11/12</b>	\$120 / student

The Student Resources Levy does not include Book List requirements and materials acquired by families through Campion unless noted as being included in the levy.

## Payment Options

College accounts are sent out at the beginning of the year in late January / early February and paid in full by **28<sup>th</sup> February 2026** unless family elect to pay the Account by instalments. Accepted payment methods are cash, cheque, EFTPOS, BPay, credit card (Mastercard or Visa) or direct debit. Online credit card payment platform is also available via MAZCOM.

Families will have the opportunity to select a payment option in 2026, with further details to be provided at the beginning of the year. If electing to pay by instalments, the instalment should be calculated as follows and the first payment is expected prior to end February 2026:

## Family Discounts

Families with more than one student **concurrently** enrolled at the College receive the following discounts on Tuition Fees only:

1 <sup>st</sup> Student Enrolled	0% - no discount applied
2 <sup>nd</sup> Student Enrolled	20%
3 <sup>rd</sup> Student Enrolled	40%
4 <sup>th</sup> and additional Students Enrolled	50%

## Music Fees

For students undertaking instrumental music lessons:

- Music tuition per semester or part thereof
  - Year 7 Introduction \$400/semester
  - Years 8-12 \$475/semester
- Instrument hire \$125 per semester or part thereof
- Starter Kit \$70 (one off payment) for Y7 registration in Music program in Term 1

***Accounts for the above are issued each semester and are payable in full 1 month after date of invoice.***

## VET Electives

As a general guide, the College Tuition Fees and Student Resources Levy covers the additional net cost of VCEVET/VM programs. Due to ongoing changes with Government funding and external RTO financial arrangements, some student VET fees may need to be passed onto families. In these instances, if required, the fees are in addition to the total College Annual Tuition Fees and Student Resources Levy. Full tuition fees apply to all students enrolled in these programs.

Please note any government funding received by the College will be deducted from any VET fees charged. If additional fees are payable, Parents / Guardians will be notified in writing.

## Re-enrolment (Current Students)

In Term 3 each year Parents / Guardians of students in Years 7 to 11 will be asked to confirm their son's re-enrolment and permissions at the College for the following year to ensure the integrity of student numbers enabling the College to commit to the educational programs and offerings of the College.

## Extra-Curricular Activities - International Language and Cultural Tours

Various language and cultural student trips are offered annually to Italy, Japan and China. All costs associated with these trips are additional to the College Annual Tuition Fee charged. For students to participate in these trips, it is expected families will be on a full fee scheduled payment plan and their Annual Tuition Fee account is not in arrears. Parents / Guardians of students who apply to attend these trips will receive a letter to identify the costs and methods of payment associated.

## 1:1 Laptop Computer Program

Mazenod College maintains a 1:1 laptop program to enabling students to enhance learning and research skills using technology. New laptops are issued to students in Year 7 and Year 10 for use over a 3-year period.

Student laptops are acquired by the College and provided to the student to support learning for the duration of their education at the College. In the event damage is sustained to the device, the College will notify the family if the repairs are not covered by warranty. An excess of \$250 is payable by families on any repairs required outside of the laptop warranty. The amount will need to be paid within 7 days of the notice being issued.

On leaving the College, the allocated laptop must be returned to the College by the student no later than the last day of attendance. Laptops that are returned damaged or without accessories will incur a charge on the final account issued by the College.

## Health Care Card

Families who hold a current Centrelink pension or Health Care Card and are eligible to receive the Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF) grant please complete the application form and attach a copy of your current Health Care Card and return to the College by June of each year.
