## **STUDENTS OF THE INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY AND DESIGN FACULTY:**

### **Certificate II in Construction Pathways / Certificate II in Engineering Pathways**

To conform to Occupational Health and Safety Requirements, students doing practical workshop subjects will be required to **provide their own CLEAR safety glasses and hearing protection (eg Howard Leight QB3 Semi-aural headband earplug) and steelcap work boots**. In addition to the above, students will be required to provide and bring to all practical classes, a suitable pencil and 5 metre retractable tape measure. Most vocational studies students involved in structured work placement will be required to supply the above whilst at work.

<b>Cert II in Engineering:</b>	Students will be required to have industry standard protective clothing as worn in the engineering workplaces. Minimum protective clothing would be cotton overalls and steel cap work boots or long cotton work trousers with a long-sleeved cotton shirt.
