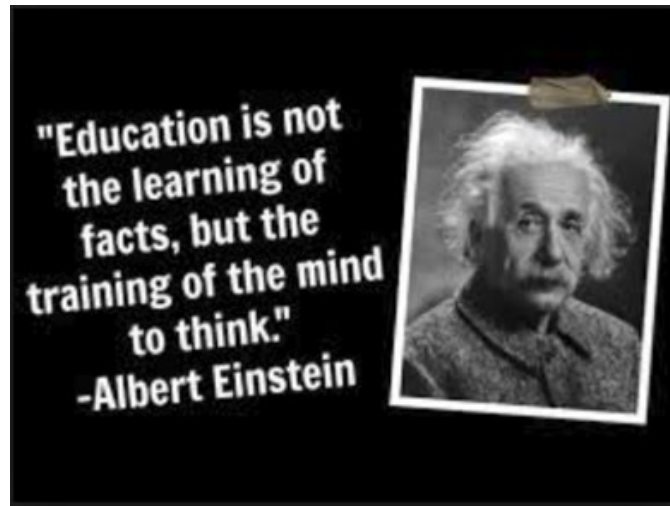
YEAR 11 ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE - UNIT I, 2026
