



## Enrolment Policy

### Entry to Mount Sinai College

Entry to Mount Sinai College is open to any student desiring a Modern Orthodox Jewish education coupled with a secular education based on the curriculum prescribed by the New South Wales Board Education Standards Authority (NESA) for Years K to 6 and Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF) for the Early Learning Centres (ELC). The ELC also comes under the auspice of the Australian Student's Education and Care, Quality Authority (ACECQA).

The College maintains a policy providing equal opportunity for boys and girls and for students with additional educational needs, where the College can provide a reasonable adjustment without causing unjustifiable hardship.

Waitlist Registration for Enrolment may be made at any time after a child is born by the parent(s), of students, to commence at Mount Sinai College.

Mount Sinai College is not currently registered to enrol students entering Australia on a Student Visa. We do however, welcome applications from families entering Australia as permanent residents, or entering on a specific, temporary visa. In this case copies of passports and visas for both parents and each student are required as part of the application.

Students enrolling in Years K (Kindergarten) for the first time must be five years of age on or before 30 April.

Students enrolling in the ELC must be at least two years of age.

The College will base any decision about offering a place to a student on:

Family relationship with the College:

- sibling of a current or ex-student in Years K-6 ahead of ELC
- sibling of a current or ex-student
- a child of an alumnus
- a child of a staff member
- they hold attitudes, values and priorities that are compatible with the College's ethos.

The student:

- the contribution that the student may make to the College, including the co-curricular activities
- the student's reports from previous schools or Early Learning environments.



Mount Sinai College:

- ability to meet the diverse needs or abilities of the student.

Other considerations:

- order of receipt- when the Waitlist Registration to enroll is received by the College.

Mount Sinai College has an absolute discretion in determining the weight of each of the factors it considers in determining whether to offer a conditional place for the student.

The Principal, Director of ELC or their delegate will meet with parent(s) and the student as part of the conditional offer of enrolment.

Continued enrolment at Mount Sinai College is dependent upon the student making satisfactory academic progress, attending consistently, and the student and the parent(s) observing all Codes of Conduct, Policies and other requirements of Mount Sinai College which are applicable from time to time.

Mount Sinai College reserves its rights under its Constitution.
