SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants for the position are required to briefly address the following selection criteria in writing. The responses should be approximately one, but no more than two pages, and be a separate document from the covering letter.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

- An understanding of and commitment to the aims of Catholic education and the mission, vision and values of Mt St Michael's College.
- Knowledge and understanding of Visual Art and materials, tools and procedures required for specific techniques
- Knowledge and understanding of safe practises when using art equipment, such as the kilns, glass, power tools, heating devices, cutting tools, hazardous materials and chemicals
- Broad computer literacy, particularly using Image Modification Programs, such as Photoshop
- Experience in a school environment and/or a desire to work in school environment.

PERSONAL QUALITIES:

- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal, to enable effective liaison with College administrators, staff, parents, students, community members and others.
- A high level of initiative, accuracy and attention to detail.
- Ability to establish cooperative working relationships with all staff at the College.
- Ability to work as a member of team, as well as independently.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENT:

- Applicants should hold a current Working With Children – 'Blue Card' ('P' class) from the QLD Department of Justice and Attorney-General.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications should include a covering letter, written responses to the Selection Criteria, and a Curriculum Vitae outlining qualifications (if applicable), relevant skills and recent experience, and the name and contact details of three professional referees.
