B'YACHAD PARENTS GROUP (6 WEEKS – 6 MONTHS)

WEEKLY SESSIONS OVER A SIX-WEEK PERIOD EACH TERM

- Brings families together.
- Each session aims to provide a relaxing and supportive environment for parents and babies.
- Specialist guest speakers on a range of topics relating to babies and parenting.
- Open to anyone from the wider Jewish community and strives to help families build connections and feel supported through an often challenging stage of life.



GAN KATAN (1 – 2 YEAR OLD CHILDREN)

WEEKLY PLAYGROUP

- Sessions include play, music and movement and incorporates opportunities for learning about Chaggim, Jewish Culture and Hebrew Language.
- Welcoming children and families from the wider Jewish community together to form connections and experience a taste of the ELC at Mount Scopus.



GAN GANI (2 – 3 YEAR OLD CHILDREN)

ONE- HOUR WEEKLY SESSION DURING SCHOOL TERM FOR CHILDREN THE YEAR BEFORE THEY START KINDER

- Children attend accompanied by a parent, grandparent or carer to participate in a range of activities together, including singing and music, dance and movement, stories, craft and Kabbalat Shabbat and Chagim, irrespective of which day they attend.
- Booked on a term-by-term basis.
- Offers parents and children the opportunity to connect with other families attending Lower Kinder the following year.
- Support for families in deciding whether their child will be ready to commence Kinder.
- It is open to children who will be attending kinder at either of our campuses and is automatically offered to children registered for kinder at Scopus.
