ACCOUNTS

College Fees are billed annually and are payable in full by the end of Week 4, Term 1. This date may only be extended if a College approved payment plan has been agreed to. Such a plan may permit weekly, fortnightly, monthly or quarterly instalments so that all fees and charges are paid in full by the end of October 2021. A monthly administration fee of \$22.00 (GST inclusive) will be charged to all College, ELC & OSHC Fee accounts in arrears. Any payment dishonour fees the College incurs from financial institutions will also be passed on to the respective account. If you are considering withdrawing your child/children from the College, please ensure you provide one full uncommenced term's notice, as per the Enrolment Agreement. Please contact our Enrolments Manager for clarification.

ENROLMENT FEES

A \$250 Application Fee is payable when a family applies to enrol their first child in the College. An additional \$250 Enrolment Fee is payable when an offer of enrolment is accepted by a family for their first child. These fees are non-refundable.

TECHNOLOGY LEVY

The College will commence a laptop provision program in 2021. This will see a new device provided on a three year loan for Years 7 and 10. The program will also include Year 11 in 2021. To secure the long-term sustainability of the program, parents will be required to pay a compulsory technology levy of \$300 towards this cost. Further information on this program will be provided separately.

PARENT PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

Primary and Secondary families are billed an annual parent participation fee of \$420 at the start of the year. Families are asked to commit 16 hours of service to the College per year. Each hour completed will attract a \$26.25 credit which will be accumulated and credited against the fee account at the end of each term up to the value of \$420 per annum.

COLLEGE BUS

The College bus service is available for a non-refundable fee of \$170 per student per term. Bus application forms are to be returned to the College by the 4 December 2020. Further details are available by contacting the College office.
