General Guidelines

The College has a compulsory uniform. The appearance of our students reflects on our College's reputation. Students in Junior School are expected to always be in full and correct school uniform as set out in the following document.

On excursion days, students not in full correct uniform will not be permitted to attend the excursion.

- All uniform items must be purchased through the College Uniform Shop, with the exception of footwear.
- Please ensure all clothing is clearly named.
- If your child is wearing a non-uniform item, a note should be sent to the class teacher explaining the circumstances.

Hats

All Junior School students must wear a Northside hat. The wearing of a College hat is essential while outdoors, to minimize exposure to the sun.

Students are expected to wear a hat:

- For any outdoor activity
- Morning tea
- Lunch
- Before/after school
- Excursions

Students who do not have a hat, are to play in shaded areas. If a student does not consistently wear a Northside hat, parents will be contacted.

Prep - Year 2: students are to wear the Legionnaire Cap

Years 3 - 9: students are to wear the Wonder Hat with the Formal Uniform

Sport Uniform: bucket hats should NOT be worn with this uniform unless undertaking 'active sport'. The bucket hat is designed to be a more

comfortable and practical to be worn when involved in sporting activities and is ONLY part of the sports uniform. Alternatively, students MAY wear the "Wonderhat" with the sports uniform as it offers superior shading.

Acceptable non-uniform clothing guidelines

These guidelines apply on occasions when school uniform is not worn - such as camps, free dress days, rehearsals and special performances etc. Students are expected to wear neat and modest clothing appropriate for the occasion.

Tops

- Tops must cover the torso
- No low-cut, see-through or revealing tops
- No shoestring strap tops or singlets
- No shirts or T-shirts with inappropriate slogans

Footwear

- For Workplace Health and Safety reasons students must wear closed shoes.
- Closed shoes / joggers are recommended on camps for safety reasons.

Modesty

- Northside (formal) dresses should be knee length.
- Uniforms should be of an appropriate fit.

Swimwear

All students are expected to wear a Sunsmart shirt or a T-shirt over swimwear at swimming lessons.

If a student is inappropriately dressed on any such occasion, their Class teacher will notify the parents.

Lost property

Lost property is on the upper floor of B Block. Please check here for any lost articles. Unnamed articles will only be kept for one week. It is essential that all children's clothing and other possessions are clearly named. We do our best to return items once found.

Jewellery Standards

- One signet ring.
- One watch.
- One pair of earrings (girls), plain thin silver or gold sleepers or studs (in earlobe only).
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Coloured nail polish is not be worn at school.
- No make-up is to be worn at school.

Footwear

Formal Uniform - traditional school shoe; black leather lace-up, polishable with medium heel.



Sports Uniform - Predominately white sports shoe with a protective and supportive sole and heel (e.g. running shoe or cross trainer) with white laces.

Middle School Uniform Guidelines

General Guidelines

The appearance of students reflects on the College's reputation and sets a tone that aligns with College attitudes and behaviours that aspire for excellence.

Students in the Secondary School are expected to always meet College expectations in wearing the full and correct uniform as set out in the Secondary School Uniform Guidelines located on the College website in the Uniform Shop Catalogue.

In Middle School, students who arrive at school out of uniform (e.g. without hat, incorrect socks, etc.) will be required to see their Form Teacher to obtain a Uniform Slip (known as a 'pink slip') prior to Period One. On excursion days, students not in full correct uniform will not be allowed to attend the excursion.

Middle School Expectations - General

- The uniform is to be worn neatly. Oversized (and undersized) clothing cannot be worn neatly and hence is not permitted. Students must wear a uniform of the correct size and in good condition. Students wearing damaged uniforms will be requested to undertake appropriate repairs or replacement in a set period of time.
- Boys are to have shirts tucked in and socks up.
- Girls' formal skirts are to sit below the knee-cap when standing
- Girls' and boys' traditional school shoes are expected to be clean and polished.

Hats

Northside believes very strongly in the importance of wearing hats. The school hat is to be worn by the student throughout the day, when outside of a building. During lessons, the hat is to be placed under the student's chair. A student found not wearing a hat outside a classroom will be issued a warning. Repeated warnings will accumulate to formal detentions.

The "Wonderhat" is the ONLY acceptable hat to be worn with the Day Uniform in Secondary School. NCC Sport caps and bucket hats should NOT be worn with this uniform unless undertaking 'active sport'; students dressed like this will be regarded as "out of uniform". The sport cap and bucket hat are designed to be more comfortable and practical hats to be worn when involved in sporting activities and are ONLY part of the sport uniform. Alternatively students MAY wear the "Wonderhat" with the sport uniform as it offers superior shading.

Free Dress, Excursions and Camps

On occasion, the Secondary School organises free dress days. The proceeds are dedicated to a range of different needs and charities; in more recent times targeting our College overseas mission's focus. The below list represents the College's expectations for students during free dress days, camps and similar events:

- Students may wear clothing of a moderate style, including jeans
- Students are not to wear too tight, too short or too revealing clothing
- Backless tops, off the shoulder, spaghetti straps and low necklines are not acceptable
- For girls, midribs should be covered
- Singlets are not permitted

- Hats will be required for EVERY outdoor activity
- Make-up is not to be worn by students
- Any equipment needed for the normal running of classes should be brought to school on these days
- Closed-in shoes must be worn for safety reasons on free dress days.
- Flipflops/thongs are not acceptable

If a student is inappropriately dressed on any such occasion, they will be sent to the relevant Year Level Coordinator.

Shoes

Formal Uniform: Traditional school shoe. Black leather lace-up, polishable with medium heel.



Sports Uniform: Sport shoes are considered to be part of the College sport uniform, and as such are required to be predominantly white in colour. Sports shoes need to provide protective support (e.g. running shoe or cross trainer with white laces); therefore, casual shoes are not permitted.

Hair and Jewellery Guidelines

Hair Standards

If the Form Teacher, Year Level Coordinator or a member of Senior Staff considers that a student needs a haircut, they will be given ONE warning and will have one week to comply. Students who turn up to school with an unacceptable cut or colour, or who persistently choose to wear their hair in an unacceptable manner, will be suspended. Below are the standards for hair.

Boys Hair

- Hair is to be well-groomed and cut in a moderate style. Styles are to be tapered with no extreme length variations (e.g. no undercuts).
- The head is not to be shaven or closely shaven in part or whole (where blades are used, no cut below a 'number 3' is acceptable).
- Hair should be no longer than the collar, should not cover the ears and should not extend below the top of the eyebrows.

- Sideburns are to be no lower than the bottom of the ear.
- Boys' hair is to be a natural colour.
- Boys' hair is not to be tied back, pushed back behind the ears and gel or any equivalent is not to be used to disguise a hairstyle which would otherwise be unacceptable.
- Male students are to be clean shaven (no beards or moustaches).

Girls Hair

- Hair is to be well-groomed and cut in a moderate style.
- Shoulder-length or longer hair should be tied back using College tartan, navy blue, white or bottle green hair accessories. The Uniform Shop offers a selection of suitable hair accessories.
- Girls' hair should be groomed so as not to fall across the eyes and face.
- The hairstyle should be such that it does not interfere with

- the wearing of the school hat.
- Girls' hair should be their natural colour.

Jewellery Standards

- One ring (rub-over style)
- One watch (not to be a smartwatch)
- One pair of earrings (girls), plain thin silver or gold sleepers or pearl/ball studs (less than 5mm diameter) in earlobe only
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings
- Necklaces are not permitted
- Coloured nail polish is not to be worn at school
- No make-up is to be worn at school.

Sports Uniform

- Middle School students are allocated two days a week to wear the sport uniform. Students also attend one PE lesson per week (a practical lesson). As much as possible, YLCs align the timetable so that the majority of PE classes align with the second day of sport. If the student is required to wear their sport uniform outside these allocated sport days, students are required to come to school in day uniform and change in the break time preceding the PE lesson and then change back into day uniform at the next break after the lesson, if applicable.
- If a T-shirt needs to be worn under the sport shirt, it must be white and should not be visible below the sleeve or waistband. It should not have any logos or designs.



Senior School Uniform Guidelines

General Guidelines

The appearance of our students reflects on our College's reputation. The day uniform sets a tone in the College that is conducive to the attitudes and behaviours that encourage excellence. Students in the Secondary School are expected to always be in full and correct school uniform as set out in the school Handbook. On excursion days, students not in full correct uniform will not be allowed to attend the excursion.

The uniform is to be worn neatly. Boys are to have shirts tucked in and socks up. Girls and boys shoes are expected to be clean and polished. Oversized (and undersized) clothing cannot be worn neatly and hence is not permitted. Students must wear uniform the correct size. Senior Boys must own a pair of formal uniform long pants as part of the formal day uniform and for use at formal events. When wearing uniform long pants boys are permitted to wear plain navy blue, grey or black business socks. Senior Girls Formal skirts are to sit below knee cap when standing.

All Senior School students are required to wear College blazers to Secondary School Assemblies during Term 2 and 3.

Sports Uniform

School sports uniform is to be worn all day only on the nominated sports day. At other times, such as for a PE class, teachers will nominate one lesson per week (which will be their practical lesson) that the students can wear their PE uniform all day. If the PE uniform is needed on other days, students are required to come to school in day uniform and change in the break time preceding the PE lesson and then change back into day uniform at the next break after the lesson, if applicable.

Sports shoes are considered to be part of the College Sports Uniform, and as such are required to be predominantly white in colour and have a protective and supportive sole and heel (e.g. running shoe or cross trainer), white laces, no boots, no high tops and no casual shoes.

If a T-shirt needs to be worn under the sports shirt it must be white and should not be visible below the sleeve or waistband. It should not have any logos or designs.

Hats

Northside Christian College believes very strongly in the importance of wearing hats at the College. The school hat is to be worn by the student throughout the day, when outside of a building. During lessons, the hat is to be placed under the student's chair. A student found not wearing a hat outside a classroom will be issued a warning. Repeated warnings will accumulate to formal detentions.

The formal hat is the ONLY acceptable hat to be worn with the Day Uniform in Senior School. The sports cap may be worn with the sports uniform. It may only be worn with the formal uniform during active sports at a break.

Year 12 Jerseys

Year 12 students are permitted to purchase special "Year 12 Jerseys". However, they are not a part of the standard school uniform and are ONLY to be worn with sports uniform. Jerseys with inappropriate nicknames printed on them will not be allowed at school.

Free Dress Guidelines

On occasion, the Secondary School organises free dress days. The

proceeds are dedicated to a range of different needs and charities, in more recent times targeting our College overseas missions thrust.

The standard of clothing expectation is as follows:

- Students may wear clothing of a moderate style, including jeans;
- Students are not to wear too tight, too short or too revealing clothing. Backless tops and low necklines are not acceptable. For girls, midriffs should be covered;
- Singlets are not permitted;
- Hats will be required for EVERY outdoor activity;
- Make-up is not to be worn by students;
- Any equipment needed for the normal running of classes should be brought to school on these days;
- Closed in shoes must be worn for safety reasons on free dress days. Thongs are not acceptable.

If a student is inappropriately dressed on any such occasion they will be sent to the relevant Year Level Coordinator.

Hair and Jewellery Guidelines

Hair Policy

Student haircuts and styles of wearing are to be in accordance with the school's haircut policy. If the Form Teacher, Year Level Coordinator or a member of Senior Staff considers that a student needs a haircut, they will be given a warning and will have appropriate time to comply. Students who persistently choose to wear their hair in an unacceptable manner can be asked not to come to school until the hairstyle meets the College policy.

Boys Hair

- Hair is to be well-groomed and cut in a moderate style.
- Hair should be no longer than the collar, should not cover the ears and should not extend below the top of the eyebrows.
- The head is not to be shaven or closely shaven in part or whole, no undercuts. (Where blades are used, no cut below a 'number 3' is acceptable).

- Boys' hair is to be a natural colour.
- Boys' hair is not to be tied back, pushed back behind the ears and gel or any equivalent is not to be used to disguise a hairstyle which would otherwise be unacceptable.
- Male students are to be clean shaven (no beards or moustaches).
- Sideburns are to be no lower than the bottom of the ear.

Girls Hair

- Hair is to be well-groomed and cut in a moderate style;
- Shoulder-length or longer hair should be tied back using navy blue, white or bottle green ribbons or scrunchies.
- Coloured clips are not permitted in the hair except for the Northside hair accessories available at the uniform ship.

- Navy headbands obtained from Uniform Shop are acceptable.
- Girls' hair should be groomed as not to fall across the eyes and face. Hair can be held back with a 7mm tortoise shell 'Alice' band purchased only through the uniform shop.
- The hairstyle should be such that it does not interfere with the wearing of the school hat.
- Girls' hair should be a natural colour.


Jewellery Standards

- One signet ring
- One watch
- One pair of earrings (girls), plain thin silver or gold sleepers or studs (in earlobe only)
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings
- Coloured nail polish is not to be worn at school
- No make-up is to be worn at school

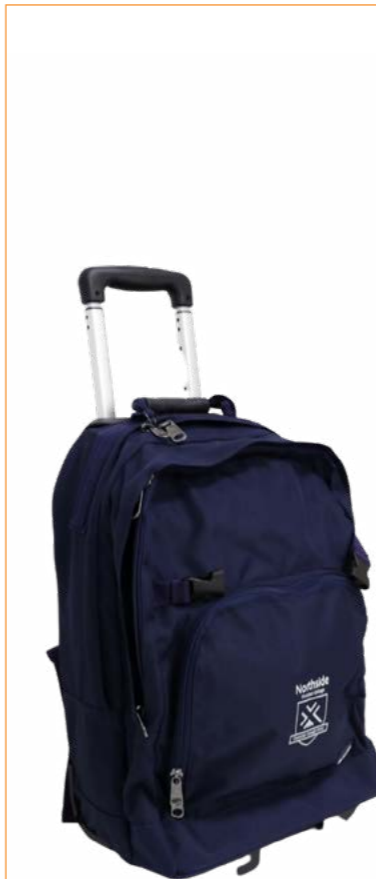

Named after Billy Graham and wife Ruth.

Billy was known for his integrity, humility and his delight in God's word influencing lives and winning souls for Jesus Christ. Ruth was his confidante and companion in their Christian work.

WESLEY HOUSE

Named after John Wesley and his mother, Susannah.

John Wesley led England's greatest spiritual awakening, convicting and redeeming a nation. In his pursuit of holiness and to preach at outdoor evangelistic meetings, he covered much of the country repeatedly on horseback.

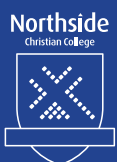
His mother, through her faith and zeal, raised John, and brother Charles, to be world-changers with the Gospel.
