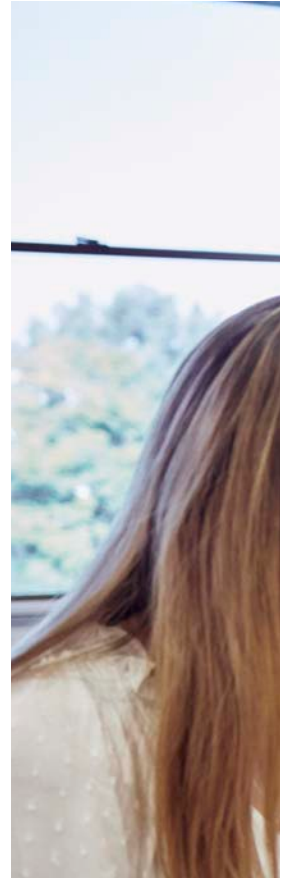

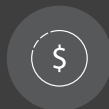

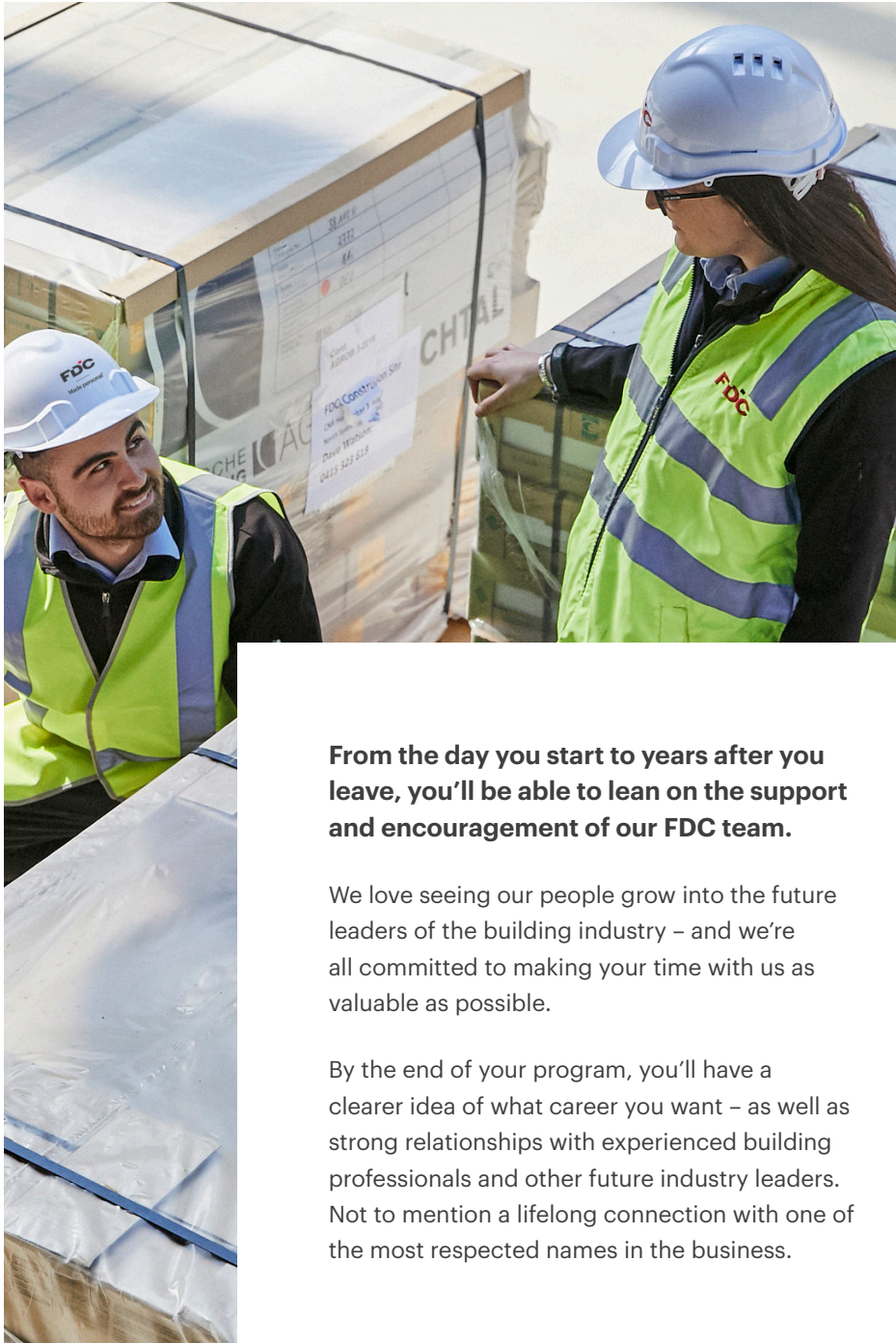
Welcome to the *family*
