## Note

- On **Thursday 9, Friday 10 and Monday 13 November** students must arrive at school at the usual time and attend Tutor Group. They will then move to the exam centre. Students will be permitted to go home at the conclusion of the session 2 examinations.
- From Tuesday 14th to Friday 17th November, students are only required to come to school for their exams. Students that are onsite but not in exams must be in the Library spaces for supervision.
- Classes resume as normal in Week 7 commencing 20 November 2023.

## General Rules

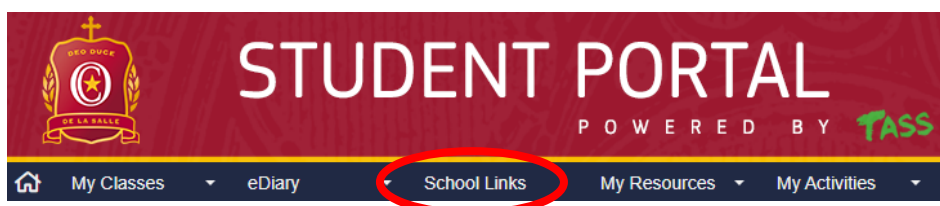
- Full College uniform is to be worn and students are to abide by College grooming standards.
- Students' College ID CARD must be brought into each examination and displayed on their desk.
- Students are to arrive at school and wait on the lawn in front of the DE Building.
- Students are to be ready to enter the De La Salle Examination Centre **30 minutes before the scheduled start of all examinations.**
- Student bags are to be left in the DE hallways ONLY. **No bags are to be left near the Chapel or Foyer.**
- Students will not be permitted to leave any examination early.

## Materials to be Brought into the Examination Room

- NO MOBILE PHONES OR OTHER DIGITAL DEVICES of any kind will be permitted in the Examination Centre, i.e. laptops, iPads, digital watches (devices that receive texts or other forms of information)
- No books or notes are to be taken into the Examination Centre unless specified on the Assessment Task Notification.
- Pencil cases must be transparent (see-through) or a clear plastic sleeve.
- Water bottles must have all labels removed and need to be clear, not coloured.
- No correction tape or liquid is permitted to be used.
- Calculators cannot have cases or lids and must be NESAs approved.
- Students are to have their own materials e.g., ruler, pens, calculator, geometry set etc.

## Illness and Absences on the day of the Examination

- Any student who is unwell or has a misadventure on the day of an examination and cannot sit for the examination, must:
  1. Obtain a detailed Doctor's Certificate, Police Report or other official evidence.
  2. Email the Academic Head and the class teacher explaining your absence, and
  3. Complete an online Illness/Misadventure application. The Illness/Misadventure application is accessible via the student portal, under the School Links tab.
- Once fit to return to school, students must sit any missed examination/s on the next available makeup session listed on the schedule.
- The only reasons for missing the next makeup examination session are if you already have a scheduled examination in that timeslot or are still unwell and your Doctor's Certificate covers the dates of absence.
- Failure to attend the makeup session will result in a ZERO mark.



## EXAMINATION CLASHES

- In the event of an examination clash, this exam will be rescheduled for the next exam makeup session. Students with exam clashes will need to come to the Curriculum Office to schedule the makeup examination.
