- Years 11 and 12 external TVET and NSW School of Languages course fees are billed to individual accounts. Any Government subsidies are credited to accounts at the end of each year.
- Years 11 and 12 internal VET fees are billed to individual accounts:
 - ▶ \$600 Construction and Hospitality
 - ▶ \$400 Entertainment and Primary Industries
- Year 11 Music Accompaniment for HSC Preliminary Assessments, are paid directly by the family.
- Year 11 Hospitality students will be required to purchase their own Chef's Uniform, toolkit and Victorinox knives via a recommended supplier (approx. \$280).

A Late Payment Fee of \$150 is applied to overdue College fee accounts after each due date, to the maximum of \$300 pa.

STUDENT UNIFORM

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EXPLANATION OF FEES

Technology Fee: This includes technology support, WiFi access, and all the software applications students require (including Office 365).

Year Levy: This includes all curriculum consumables and compulsory activities for the Year group, such as camps, retreats, excursions and class activities.

Capital Levy: This contributes to capital and refurbishments at the College, enhancing facilities and improving learning environments.

Voluntary Tax-Deductible Building Fund Contribution: Contributions to the Building Fund are voluntary donations and tax deductible. The College encourages the community to support the College's Master Plan by donating to the Building Fund.

BYOD: Oakhill College operates a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) laptop program. This creates a greater sense of ownership and connection between the student and the device. The device must be 'laptop' or 'laptop-style', needs to meet minimum College requirements and be purchased separately, prior to commencement at Oakhill College.

FEE INFORMATION

Oakhill College fees are billed at the start of each calendar year.

FEE PAYMENT OPTIONS

Oakhill College offers fee payment options to pay your fees. School Easy Pay allows you to select the payment frequency and direct debit options from a bank account or credit card. ENROLMENT AND ADMINISTRATION FEES

Enrolment Acceptance Fee	\$2,000
Administration Fee (non-refundable)	\$300 Year 7-10 and \$350 for Year 11

ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable fee of \$165 should accompany the initial online *Expression of Interest (EOI)*, otherwise your application will not be processed.

ENROLMENT ACCEPTANCE AND ADMINISTRATION FEE

A non-refundable Administration Fee of \$300 or \$350 and an Enrolment Deposit of \$2,000 is payable at the time of acceptance of an offer of enrolment. After commencement at the College, the Enrolment Deposit is refundable on withdrawal of the student provided a full term's notice is given to the College (otherwise it is treated as fee in lieu of notice) or refundable at the end of Year 12 provided that the fee account is not in arrears. The payment of \$2,300 or \$2,350 is non-refundable and payable prior to commencement at the College.
