Examination Rules and Procedures

- Full College uniform is to be worn and students are to abide by College grooming standards.
- Students are to arrive at school and wait in the MacKillop Yard – near the Learning Commons.
- Students are to be ready to enter the De La Salle Examination Centre **30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Examination.**
- Your ID CARD must be brought into each examination and displayed on the desk.
- NO MOBILE PHONES OR OTHER DIGITAL DEVICES OF ANY KIND will be permitted in the Exam Centre, ie. laptops, iPads, digital watches (devices that receive texts or other forms of information)
- NO books or notes are to be taken into the Examination Centre unless specified.
- Bags to be left in the DE hallways ONLY. No bags are to be left near the Chapel.
- If you are unwell on the day of the exam you must provide a detailed Doctor's Certificate and email/phone the Director of Student Learning to inform them of the need for an Illness or Misadventure application. The Illness and Misadventure application is [now electronic via the parent portal under the Links tab](#) or on the [student portal dashboard](#). You should make every attempt to sit the exam. In these cases, you will be required to complete make-up Examinations.
- Refer to "Assessment Schedules & Policy" in the College Diary regarding Illness /Misadventure Claims.
- Pencil cases should be transparent (see-through) or a clear plastic sleeve.
- Water bottles are not to have any labels on them and need to be clear not coloured
- No correction tape or liquid is permitted to be used.
- Students will not be permitted to leave any examination early.
- Calculators should not have cases or lids and be NESAs approved.
- No toilet breaks during examinations.
- All students are to have their own materials e.g. Ruler, pens, etc.
- Students with Disability Provisions should go directly to Exam room 1 for each exam to receive further instructions.
