Sydney Tower is Sydney's tallest structure and the second tallest observation tower in the Southern Hemisphere. Discover 360-degree views of beautiful Sydney from our indoor Observation Deck, located 250 meters above the city streets.

- **8.30am** Explore and enjoy the picturesque Bennelong Point

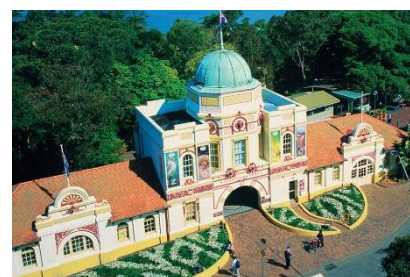
- 8.30am** **Sydney Opera House Tour**

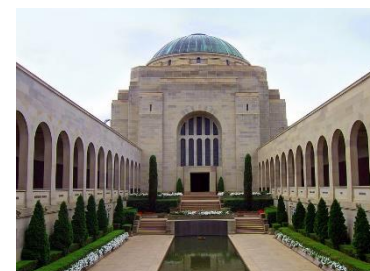
