



CAR PARK GUIDELINES

Purpose

Peter Moyes Anglican Community School (the School) has two main Car Parks – the Eastern Car Park on Salerno Drive and the Western Car Park on Elliston Parade. As with all schools, our Car Parks are especially busy at the beginning and end of each school day.

Members of the School Community who use these Car Parks are expected to adopt a careful and responsible manner, with the safety of self and others the highest priority. A collaborative and considerate approach with adherence to all guidelines and rules is the most effective way to reduce congestion and limit delays. All parents/guardians, staff and visitors must work together to assist each other. Individuals who place their needs above that of others by ignoring the guidelines and rules risk the safety of others and increase traffic congestion.

It is an expectation that all members of the School Community; visitors, staff, parents/guardians and students, follow the road rules and parking restrictions in place when in proximity to the School. In particular, making U-turns, parking in restricted areas (including bus bays) or stopping on the roadway to allow students to exit or enter a vehicle are discouraged due to safety reasons.

School Car Parks

It is an expectation that all members of the community using the Car Parks follow the guidelines and rules as set out below.

- Parents/guardians and visitors using the Car Parks are required to follow Staff directions
- The maximum speed is 5km/h in all Car Parks.
- Vehicles must adhere to the direction of travel arrows, 'No Entry' and 'No Exit' signs and other signs and road markings.
- Vehicles must not stop in the entrances to the Car Parks, areas marked 'Keep Clear' and 'No Standing Zone'.
- Parents/guardians are to use the dedicated 'drop off / pick up zone' or 'Kiss and Ride' areas when dropping off and collecting students in the Car Parks. When using these areas:
 - Parking is limited to a maximum of 2 minutes. After 2 minutes parked, all vehicles must leave and drive around to re-enter the Car Park.
 - Vehicles must move forward as far as space allows before allowing students to leave the vehicle.
 - Parents/guardians collecting a Primary School student before 3:00pm may NOT wait in the 'drop off / pick up zone' or 'Kiss and Ride' areas for Secondary School students.
- Visitors, parents/guardians and students are not permitted to use Staff Parking at any time during the School day.
- Reserved parking bays are for authorised vehicles only.
- Visitor parking bays may not be used for the dropping off and picking up of students.
- Pedestrians are to use the allocated pathways and cross overs only. It is not acceptable for pedestrians to use the car exit/entry points.
- Students wishing to drive themselves to and from School must follow the 'Travelling to and from School' Policy.

Eastern (Salerno Drive) Car Park

The Eastern Car Park is divided into three sections with entry/exit points between each. The direction of traffic is **one way in the northern section and southern section. The central section traffic is two way**. Please observe and obey the painted directional arrows and entry/exit signs. Entry points are near the Primary School (Southern Section) and the Gymnasium (Northern Section). The exit points are near School the Year 7 Reception and the Hard Courts (North Oval).

The Eastern Car Park is for staff parking only.

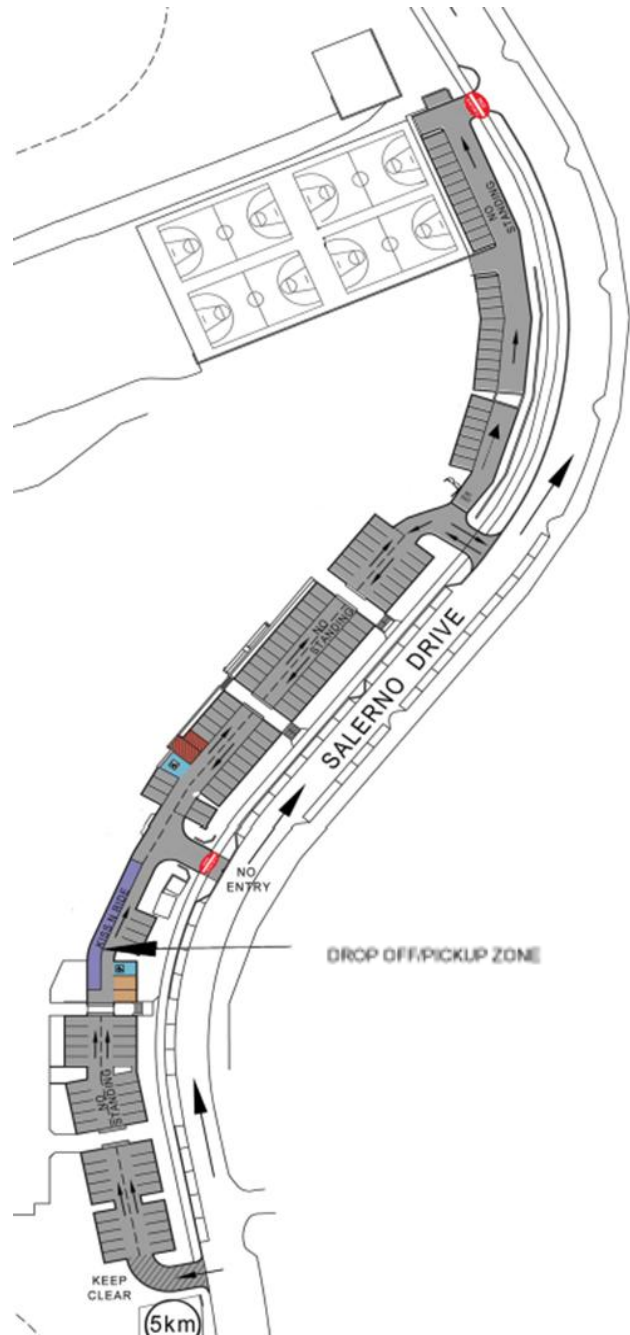
Parents/guardians may enter the Car Park to drop off and pick up students each morning and afternoon in the yellow 'drop off zones'. Entry to the **Eastern Car Park** for pick up or set down only is from the southern (Mindarie) end.

Vehicles **should be stationary for no longer than two minutes** and they are not to be left double-parked. Under no circumstances should the entrances to the Car Park from Salerno Drive or Salerno Drive itself be blocked by stationary cars. If there is no room in the 'drop off zones' then cars must exit and drive around the block to re-enter the car park.

Parents/guardians can park off campus in the available marked parking bays along Salerno Drive. Please take note of parking signs as some bays have time restrictions. These bays are monitored by the City of Wanneroo Rangers and fines can be issued for incorrect use.

All vehicles should approach the Salerno Drive Car Park from the south (Mindarie) end and turn left into the Car Park. Cars arriving at the School from the north and bound for the **Salerno Drive Car Park** should travel south along Elliston Parade, east along Anchorage and then north up Salerno Drive to enter the Car Park via a left hand turn as shown in the map. Vehicles exiting the Car Park should turn left into Salerno Drive towards Quinns Road.

There is a "Kiss and Ride" located on Salerno Drive directly in front of the Year 7 Reception. Vehicles **should be stationary for no longer than two minutes**. Please note that this is a **standing only zone (no parking or leaving a vehicle is permitted)** for the purpose of pick up and drop off only.



Western (Elliston Parade) Car Park

The Western (Elliston Parade) Car Park is **one way**. Please observe and obey the painted directional arrows and entry/exit signs.

The parking bays in the northern section of the Western Car Park (outside Main Administration and the Secondary School Reception) are for staff and short-term visitors to the School (excluding parents/guardians during collection times); in marked bays only.

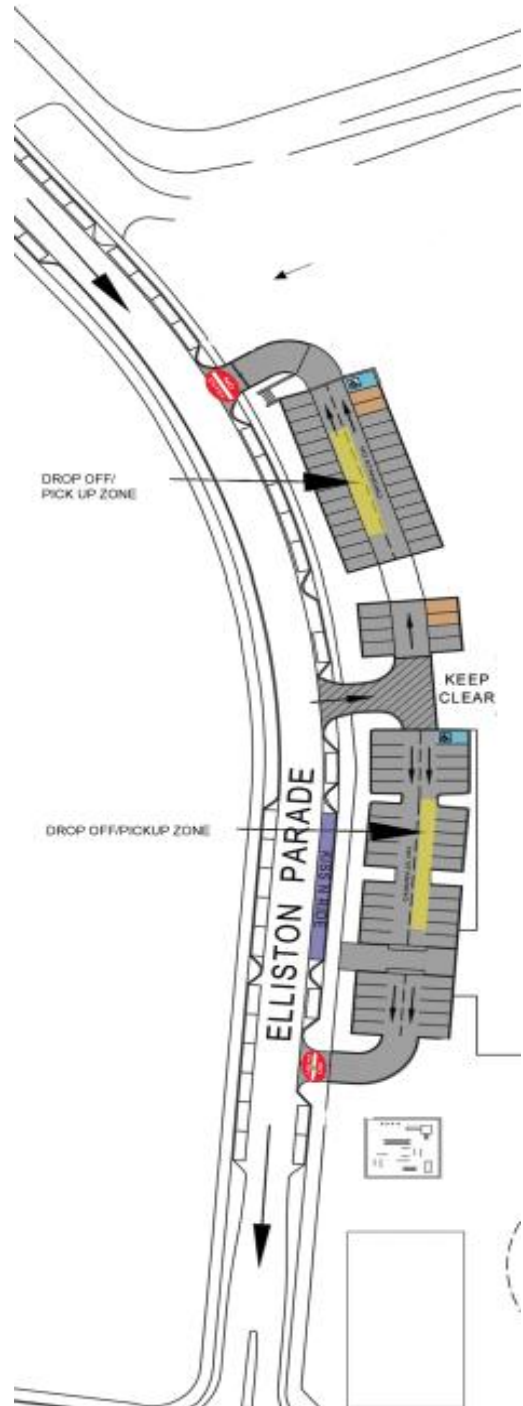
The parking bays in the southern section of the Western Car Park (near Primary School Reception) are for use by parents/guardians of Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten and Pre-Primary students only.

Other parents/guardians may enter the Car Park to drop off and pick up students each morning and afternoon in the yellow 'drop off zones'. Vehicles **should be stationary for no longer than two minutes**. Under no circumstances should the entrance to the Western Car Park from Elliston Parade or Elliston Parade itself be blocked by stationary cars. If there is no room in the 'drop off zones' then cars must exit and drive around the block to re-enter the Western Car Park.

Entry to the Western Car Park is from the central entrance only. Drivers must approach from the north and turn left, as there is no entry from the south. Cars approaching from the south, bound for the Elliston Parade Car Park, should travel north along Salerno Drive and return via Elliston Parade and make a left-hand turn into the Car Park as shown in the map. Vehicles exiting the Car Park should turn left into Elliston Parade.

There is also a "Kiss and Ride" located off-campus on Elliston Parade directly in front of the Primary School entrance. Parents/guardians are encouraged to use this as much as possible to avoid driving into the School grounds. Please note that this is a **standing only** zone (**no parking or leaving a vehicle is permitted**) for the purpose of pick up and drop off only.

Parents/guardians can park off campus in the available marked parking bays along Elliston Parade. Please take note of parking signs as some bays have time restrictions. These bays are monitored by the City of Wanneroo Rangers and fines can be issued for incorrect use.



Speed in the car parks should be no more than a crawl! It is important to remember that small children cannot see over cars and their peripheral vision is not fully developed until well into adolescence. Children can be distracted and may not look!
