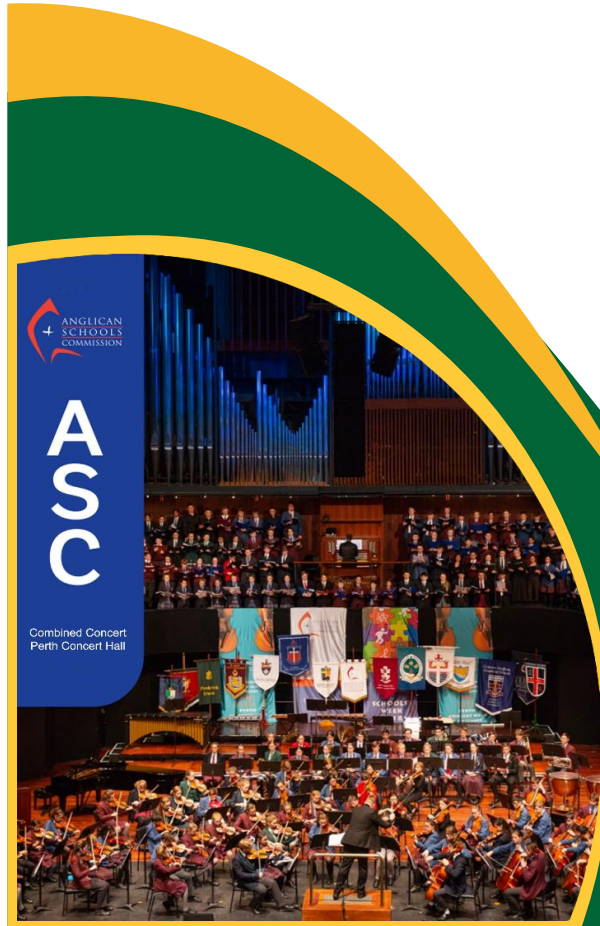

1. All students are strongly encouraged to join one of the School choirs, contemporary bands or instrumental ensembles.
2. I will be charged for missed lessons. However, there will be no charge when 24 hours' notice has been given, or if my child has an excursion or calendared School activity.
3. If an instrumental tutor misses a lesson, the lesson will be refunded. In some instances, the tutor may be able to make-up for missed lessons.
4. Students NOT wishing to continue lessons the following term must give notice to the Music Assistant no later than two weeks before the end of the current term.
5. I will be aware of my child's instrumental timetable, and will monitor his/her attendance.
6. I will encourage regular practice.
7. My contact details will be kept up to date, so that I can be contacted by the School or teacher.
8. Once I receive lesson and teacher availability and a link to the Trybooking site from the Music Assistant, I will process the payment through Trybookings. Once payment is processed, I will receive final confirmation of the lessons for the term.
