



PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Purpose

Peter Moyes Anglican Community School (the School) aims to provide a welcoming, inclusive and safe environment. The School Values are Faith, Excellence, Compassion, Respect, Responsibility and Courage. The Parent Code of Conduct (the Code) outlines the way in which the School community requires all parents/guardians and family members to conduct themselves when visiting the School, participating in School activities and communicating with community members.

This Code and its related Guidelines apply to all adults of the School community, and any others, while involved in activities or communication related to the School. Neither the Policy nor the Guidelines preclude any person from exercising their individual legal rights in respect of obtaining restraining and intervention orders, reporting assault, bringing action for defamation or exercising their rights under vilification or discrimination.

The Code is based on the following general principles which always apply in any communication with the School and its community by the provision of:

- Creating a safe workplace
- Using courteous and acceptable communication
- Acting ethically
- Respecting the rights of others.

There is a clear escalation process for issues, complaints and feedback within the School's structure. Parents/Guardians have the right to raise issues or concerns related to the education of their child, or a breach of the Policy regarding a School matter. These should be raised with the most appropriate person and follow the correct communication channels.

When making a complaint parents/guardians should refer to the School's Complaints and Disputes Resolution Policy, which is available on the School website. The Principal or Delegate will investigate the complaint by following the relevant processes.
