



WAVES CAFÉ POLICY

Purpose

At Peter Moyes Anglican Community School (the School), the Waves Café (Café) provides students, staff and its community with a selection of reasonably priced, healthy and nutritious foods for recess and/or lunch. The Café also offers catering for School events.

The Café is located in the Creative Arts building, opposite the entrance to the Allan Shaw Centre. The Café seeks to achieve an appropriate balance between preferences and demands for dietary requirements whilst striving to promote the sale of healthy food and drink options. Prices are kept to a minimum; however, set at a level that will cover all the operational costs incurred whilst offering this service to the School community.

The Café allows Primary School students to place lunch orders only; Secondary School students purchase over the counter foods at recess and/or lunch. The menu is seasonal with a different menu offered each term, with the focus on homemade items. The menu differs between Primary and Secondary School to support the dietary needs and food interests of students. Canned soft drinks are only available on House Charity Days, which generally occur once a term.

The Café aims to be a nut free environment; however, cannot guarantee that items being brought in are completely free from traces of nuts. Gluten free and vegetarian options are available. Therefore, the School encourages those with allergies to be sensible and vigilant when purchasing food from the Café. It is recommended that students with severe allergies only bring food from home and do not purchase from the Café.

It is not possible to place orders by phone or email as the Café is a cashless venue. Secondary School students will need to have a Smart Rider card which is preloaded in order to make purchases from the Café. EFTPOS is available with a minimum \$5.00 purchase value. Primary School students need to order their lunches online with Lunches delivered to the classrooms at the start of lunch.
