Rules and Conventions of Wearing the School Uniform

Peter Moyes Anglican Community School (the School) expects all students come to School each day in correct uniform. Correct uniform must also be worn when travelling to and from School. The School Uniform is available from the School Uniform Shop.

Winter Uniform is worn in Terms 2 and 3. Summer Uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4. A plain black or dark navy leather belt, available from the Uniform Shop, must be worn with trousers and shorts.

At Formal functions the Winter Uniform is worn by students in Years 7 to 12. For girls, formal wear includes navy or black opaque stockings.

Students in Pre-Kindergarten to Year 2 wear black sports shoes with a flexible sole. Pre-Kindergarten and Pre-primary students require Velcro ties, while students in Years 1 and 2 have the option of either Velcro or lace up.

For students from Years 3 to 12, school shoes are to be black leather, flat sole and low heel, full cover, in lace up only. Shoes should have their laces tied at all times and shoes kept in a good, clean condition. School shoes must provide adequate support and protection. Refer to **School Shoes** in this document.

For students from Years 3 to 12, sports shoes must be worn in accordance with the School's guidelines, available in the Uniform Shop.

Primary School students are to wear their School Sports Uniform to and from School on the days that they have Physical Education lessons.

Secondary School students are to wear their House Sports Uniform to and from School on the day that they have a House activity.

Students who have sport after lunch, or who may be in an after-school Co-Curricular activity that involves changing into Sports Uniform, may leave School in their School Sports Uniform.

At sporting matches and practices, at Physical Education and relevant Co-Curricular afternoon events, students must wear the full Sports Uniform or other prescribed dress, such as whites for cricket.

Navy blue School socks should be worn at all times and must be worn at the appropriate height: above the ankle bone and below the calf.

School jumper and blazer sleeves are not to be pulled up to the elbows and jumpers should not be tied around the waist.

Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.

Skirts and dresses should be long enough to meet the top of the knee.

Undergarments should not be visible through or under the School Uniform.

All students must have their sun hats at School on every School day. Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6 students are required to wear the School sun hat whenever outdoors. Secondary School students are required to wear the School sun hat in Terms 1 and 4. Sun hats are available from the Uniform Shop.



Students are encouraged to apply sunscreen regularly.

The School scarf may be worn outdoors as part of the Winter Uniform. Scarves are not to be worn at formal occasions, including School Assembly and Chapel.

During the winter terms of Terms 2 and 3, the blazer must be worn by Secondary School students as their outer garment when travelling to and from School. The blazer is also to be worn at formal occasions and when representing the School. The Year 12 Leaver's Jacket is not to be worn at formal school events.

When raining, students may wear the School's waterproof jacket when coming to and from the School; however, the waterproof jacket may not be worn inside the School buildings as an outer garment. The School's Sports Uniform jacket may only be worn as an outer garment as part of their Sports Uniform on the days they have sport.

Expectations of Personal Appearance

Students must meet the requirement that their dress and personal appearance reflect the high standards expected. This is of particular importance when students are seen in the School Uniform in the wider community. Students are also expected to maintain the code of personal appearance on the sports field, as spectators or at any time whilst wearing their School Uniform in the community.

Hair

Hair must be neat, tidy and clean, off the face, with fringes clearing the eyebrows. Hair should not fall below the collar line. If hair falls below the collar line, it must be tied back in a ponytail at the nape of the neck. Hair ties, clips and headbands should be the same as the natural hair colour or the School colours of white, navy, black or School Tartan.

Hairstyles are to be neat, appropriate and conservative in style. As such, any unnatural highlights, lines, shapes, undercuts or mullet styles cut into the hair are not permitted. Hair must not have contrasts in length.

Hair should not be cut shorter than a "number 2". Unadorned braided hair is acceptable. Students choosing to dye their hair should only do so in a natural hair colour.

In all matters concerning the styling and appearance of students' hair, the School's Executive Team has the sole authority and discretion to determine what it considers appropriate to uphold the intent of these guidelines.



Nails

It is the expectation that fingernails should be maintained in a neat, tidy, natural and conservative manner. No nail colour or French tip manicures are permitted, and Acrylic fingernails are not to be worn. For safety reasons, the length of fingernails should be appropriate.

Make up

Make up is not permitted to be worn by students. All students should adopt a natural and conservative appearance. Eye lash extensions are not permitted.

Facial Hair

Male students must be clean shaven. However, Year 12 students are permitted to have neatly groomed facial hair with permission. Parents/Guardians of a secondary student in lower years may seek permission, in writing from the Dean of Students for their child to wear a short, neatly clipped beard on the basis of their religion or other specified requirements.

Jewellery

Jewellery is not to be worn, apart from a standard watch or a plain medical alert bracelet. In the event that students have their ears pierced, one pair only of small, nondescript, in plain gold or silver round studs or sleepers may be worn in the ear lobe. Any other ear piercings must have a clear stud at all times. Additional ear piercings should occur during summer break to accommodate healing time before commencing the school year. No other facial piercings, including the tongue or nose, are permitted. Tattoos are strictly prohibited.

In the Primary School "Smart watches" or similar which have electronic capabilities for internet connection, are not permitted. In the Secondary School, they are permitted except during examinations and assessments, as per the rules and regulations of the School Curriculum and Standards Authority. In the Secondary School "Smart watches" may be used as a standard watch. In the event that they are used as a mobile device, they may be confiscated. This includes use in the Café for purchases.

Any student whose appearance is contrary to the dress and personal grooming expectations may be sent home until such time as their appearance meets the expectations of the School and assurances have been received from the student and his/her parents/guardians, that appropriate dress and grooming will be maintained in the future.

Parents/Guardians may in writing, seek permission from the relevant Head of School for any exceptions to the above, such as permission for their child to wear a chain or a cross of special religious significance.

The Principal's discretion and decisions as to whether a student's uniform and/or appearance is acceptable are absolute.

Non-Uniform Day Dress Standards

The dress and personal grooming of students should, at all times, reflect the high standards expected by the School. Dress should be 'Smart Casual'.

Students are to ensure that clothing is modest and not excessively revealing or tight.

Skirts and shorts should be a reasonable length, that is a similar length to the School sports shorts. Shoulders, midribs and chests are to be covered. Undergarments should not be visible. Images, logos and writing on any item of clothing must not be offensive.

The School's rules concerning hair, make-up and jewellery are to be observed. It is expected that students' hairstyles are sensible and reflect the conservative and professional nature of the School. Hair must be neat, tidy and clean. Extreme hairstyles are not to be worn.

Shoes should be closed with low heels and provide adequate support and protection. Trainers are preferred.

Hats should provide adequate protection from the sun. Hats may not be worn inside.

Students must wear their sports uniform for Physical Education lessons, House Events and School Sport.

Any student whose appearance is contrary to the above guidelines may be sent home until such time as their appearance meets the expectations of the School.

Uniform Shop Information

The Uniform Shop is run on a part time basis and is located in the Main Administration Building.

Secondary School Boys Summer

- French Navy tailored shorts with Navy belt or French Navy trousers with Navy belt
- White Short sleeved shirt with School Crest
- Emerald Green School jumper
- French Navy School socks with trousers
- French Navy School socks with shorts
- Black, flat sole & low heel, leather, full cover shoes in lace-up only *
- Refer to **School Shoes** in this policy
- School sun hat.



Secondary School Girls Winter

- White short sleeved shirt with School Crest
 - School tie
 - French Navy skirt that meets the top of the knee or French Navy trousers with Navy belt
 - French Navy School socks with trousers
 - French Navy School socks or black tights with skirt
 - Emerald Green School jumper
 - Blazer with School Crest
 - Black, flat sole & low heel, leather, full cover shoes in lace-up only *
- Refer to **School Shoes** in this policy
- School waterproof jacket, optional
 - School scarf, optional.



Secondary School Boys Winter

- White short sleeved shirt with School Crest
 - School tie
 - French Navy trousers with Navy belt
 - Emerald Green School jumper
 - Blazer with School Crest
 - French Navy School socks
 - Black, flat sole & low heel, leather, full cover shoes in lace-up only *
- Refer to **School Shoes** in this policy
- School waterproof jacket, optional
 - School scarf, optional.



Winter Uniform Year 7 to 12

- At Formal functions the winter uniform is worn by students in Years 7 – 12. Girls must wear tights
- The tie and blazer are compulsory components of Winter Uniform.

Year 12 Students

Year 12 students also wear the “Year 12 Tie” instead of the regular School tie, available at the Uniform Shop. Additionally, each year the Year 12 cohorts design their ‘Leavers’ Jacket and it is presented to them. Year 12 students may wear their ‘Leavers’ garment to and from and around the School following its presentation. However, this privilege may be withdrawn by the Dean of Students if there is consistently inappropriate wearing of the ‘Leavers’ Jacket by Year 12 students and/or behaviour by Year 12 students. The Leavers Jacket:

- May be worn during Terms, 1 - 3 except during formal occasions
- Should not pull up the jacket sleeves
- May be worn socially. Students are to be aware on such occasions that they are clearly recognisable as a representative of the School, and their behaviour should reflect the School’s values.

Years 7 to 12

Dance Uniform

Years 10 to 12

- Black ‘fitted’ dance leggings
- Black leotard optional for lessons but required for ALL practical assessments and examinations
- Black t-shirt or singlet with thick straps
- Dance jacket, optional
- Water bottle
- All jewellery removed
- Bare feet for all lessons.

Special Notes

Years 3 to 6

The School waterproof jacket is the only jacket to be worn in cold or inclement weather. The School jumper may be the outer garment if so desired, but no other jacket is permissible.



Years 7 to 12

The School Blazer is the compulsory outer garment to be worn in cold weather during Terms 2 and 3. A School jumper may be worn under a School blazer in Terms 2 and 3 or as the outer garment in Terms 1 and 4. When raining, students may wear the School’s waterproof jacket to and from the School, but **the waterproof jacket may not be worn around the School as an outer garment**. The School jumper may not be worn with the Sports Uniform.



School Shoes

As stated in the Student Handbook and in these Guidelines: for students from Years 3 to 12, school shoes are to be black leather, flat sole and low heel, full cover, in lace-up only. Shoe laces are to be tied at all times and shoes kept in a good, clean condition. School shoes must provide adequate support and protection.

Parents/Guardians purchasing new shoes are advised to refer to the tables below to ensure an appropriate shoe is purchased.

Wedged high heels, flat soled shoes with no heel, dress shoes, trainers or skate shoes and dance shoes are not permitted.

School Sport Shoes

Students are permitted to wear appropriate, closed supportive sport shoes/runners/cross trainers with laces. However, these must be proper exercise shoes and not canvas, gym boots, indoor soccer shoes or slip-on shoes. Sports shoes must be a sports-based trainer that has athletic elements to it, not fashion shoes. They must provide excellent foot support and a dual-purpose sole. Shoes should be made of light mesh-based materials and non-marking soles.

Parents/Guardians purchasing new sports shoes are advised to refer to the tables below to ensure an appropriate shoe is purchased. If in doubt, please contact the Sports Department prior to purchase.

The following shoes are permitted to be worn when representing an Inter-School Sporting Team only:-

- Basketball shoes for Basketball
- Athletics Spikes for Athletics
- Indoor and Outdoor Soccer Boots
- AFL boots.
