



# TRAVELLING TO AND FROM SCHOOL POLICY

---

## Purpose

Peter Moyes Anglican Community School (the School) understands its students take a variety of transport to and from School. The suitable mode of transport is decided between the parent/guardian and their child. The School requires all students to use a safe and legal mode of transport when travelling to and from School and are reminded that, as with all personal property, their cars, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, eScooters or motorised scooters are stored at their own risk.

To be clear, the use of eScooters, eRideables, and eBikes is prohibited at Peter Moyes Anglican Community School for all students from Kindergarten through Year 10. The ban does not apply to students in Years 11 and 12.

Bicycles, scooters, skateboards motorised scooters and eScooters, or other eRideables, are not permitted to be used on the School's grounds and must be walked or held at all times. On leaving the School, riders must wait until they have left the School grounds and are past the congestion of cars and people before mounting their ride.

Students using bicycles, eScooters or motorised scooters must comply with their legal obligations to wear a helmet. Students using scooters and/or skateboards as a means of transport to and from School are also required to wear helmets for their safety.

Any student who travels to and from School on a bicycle, eScooter or motorised scooter must keep it in the bicycle enclosure. Students are required to use personal locks or security devices. The safety and care of the mode of transport is the responsibility of the student, not the School or its staff.

Years 11 and 12 students with a valid driver's license may choose to drive to and from School. This includes mopeds/scooters. Those students must abide by the Students Driving to School Guidelines.

Cars or mopeds/scooters are not to be used by students during the School day, between 8:05am and 3:05pm, unless to an approved School activity for which permission has been obtained from the School.

No cars or mopeds/scooters driven by students to School are to be parked on the School premises during the School day, unless the student has a permit to park near the Gymnasium.
