

2026 Student Device Lease Agreement Terms and Conditions

These are the device specifications and leasing terms for the device leasing option provided by the College.

Agreement Terms

Duration and Ownership

The **Lease Agreement** will remain in effect, and the **Device** (including all accessories) will remain the property of the College until **one of the following occurs**:

1. The College receives the full cost of the Lease Agreement; **OR**
2. The Device (including all accessories) is returned to the College in **serviceable condition**.

Early Termination and Adjustments

A family with an active Lease Agreement may request an amendment to the terms, such as an early release from the agreement. Such a request must be made **in writing** to the Business Office, clearly stating the requested adjustment and the reasons for it. The Business Office will then review the application.

Cessation of Enrolment

If a family with an active Lease Agreement ceases enrolment at Pacific Lutheran College, the family must choose one of the following options:

1. **Surrender the Device:** Return the Device (including all accessories) to the College in **serviceable condition** without any further lease charges.
2. **Purchase the Device:** Pay the remaining lease cost (as determined by the Business Office) to retain ownership of the Device.

End of Lease Transfer of Ownership

Upon the conclusion of the lease term, ownership of the Device will transfer to the family. The family will be charged a **nominal release fee** (currently less than \$10) to cover the College's legal tax obligations for the transfer of ownership.

Device Restoration and Data Responsibility

At the conclusion of the Lease Agreement, the College will restore the Device to its **original "factory" Windows operating system image**. This process will remove all College-supplied applications, software, and any user data present on the Device. **It is the family's sole responsibility to ensure all personal, non-College data is safely backed up prior to the restoration being performed.**

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Warranty & Insurance

Insurance Coverage Provided by the College

Devices leased through the College program are covered by an **Extended Warranty and Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) insurance** for the full term of the lease.

What is Covered:

- Repair of unintentional accidental damage caused by drops, falls, or collisions.
- Damage resulting from liquid being spilled on or into the Device.
- Damage caused by a power surge.

Coverage Limits and Excess:

- The insurance terms allow for a maximum of three (3) repairs and one (1) replacement over the three-year lease period.
- There is a zero-dollar (\$0) excess charge for all covered claims.

What is NOT Covered (College Coverage Exclusions):

- Damage caused by "acts of nature", such as bush fire, rain, or flood.
- Theft or Loss of the device.

Family Responsibility for Theft and Loss

The College's insurance **does not cover theft or loss** of the leased device. Insurance coverage for these events is the **sole responsibility of the leasing family**.

- **Action Required:** Families must check with their own insurance provider (e.g., Home and Contents policy) regarding the terms and conditions for covering the device against theft and/or loss.
- **Liability:** Should the device be **lost or stolen** while in the family's care, the family is responsible for the **full cost of replacing the device** if their personal insurance coverage is denied or has not been arranged.

Conclusion of Lease

At the conclusion of the Lease Agreement, all insurance coverage provided by the College ceases, and any required repair costs become the **family's responsibility**.

Internet Filtering Scope and Responsibility

Pacific Lutheran College provides internet content filtering **only when devices are connected directly to the College network**.

Filtering is NOT Active when the Device is:

- Connected through a Virtual Private Network (VPN).
- Connected to any network outside of the College (e.g., a home network).
- Connected via mobile hot-spotting through a personal device.

This limitation on filtering applies universally to **all devices**, including College-owned, College-leased, and Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) equipment.

Families are responsible for supervising internet use and ensuring appropriate filtering when the device is used off the College network.
