## **Principal's Message | COVID-19 UPDATE | Thursday 26 March 2020**

Given the Queensland Government's decision today to hold five pupil free days next week, the following arrangements will be implemented at Rivermount College.

- The College will continue to deliver online learning on Monday and Tuesday of next week to enable us to thoroughly test our online learning platforms.
- Students of essential workers, needing to attend school, will be supervised to complete their online learning.
- All assessment for Year 11 and Year 12 students will continue as planned. Students are expected to complete all written examinations at the College.
- From Wednesday, the College will implement pupil free days for the remainder of Term One. This is to provide teaching staff with the necessary time to further prepare teaching resources for the potential of continuing online learning next term.
- Parental and student feedback on our online learning will be very beneficial to assist staff to improve and make necessary adjustments. Please email your feedback to relevant teachers and senior staff. Email addresses can be found in the Parent Lounge Portal.
- In line with Education Queensland the College will provide supervised activities from Wednesday for parents who are working and have no alternative supervision arrangements for their children. Please email [enrolments@rivermount.qld.edu.au](mailto:enrolments@rivermount.qld.edu.au) if your child/children will be in attendance. This will allow us to arrange appropriate supervision.
- Before and after school care, operated by TeamKids, will continue as normal.
- The College remains open for students to submit assessment throughout next week. Normal assessment expectations will be applied.
